

# Taronga Zoo Wharf Upgrade

Investigation work from Saturday 16 October 2021

The NSW Government is upgrading Taronga Zoo Wharf as part of the Transport Access Program – an initiative to deliver modern, safe and accessible transport infrastructure across the state.

Transport for NSW will carry out investigation work to help inform the detailed design for the Taronga Zoo Wharf Upgrade.

## What does the work involve?

The work will involve using a hand-held wand to locate underground services, an overhead drone survey to scan the site surface, condition assessment of the jetty, wharf and pontoon.

We will also be carrying out underwater dive investigations, taking small samples of the existing wharf for testing, and geotechnical surveys which will involve drilling a borehole to inspect underground conditions. Once the work is complete we will reinstate the area.

## Our work schedule

The work is expected to take three weeks to complete, weather permitting, starting from Saturday 16 October 2021.

Our work hours are Monday to Friday from 7am to 5pm, and Saturdays from 7am to 1pm.

## How our work may impact you

There may be some noise associated with the drilling of the borehole, however this is not expected to take more than two days to complete. The work will not impact ferry or bus services.

We ask pedestrians and motorists to take care when navigating around our work areas.
