



Road closure at the M4 Motorway westbound on-ramp

January 2022

Transport for New South Wales is finalising work along The Northern Road between Glenmore Park and South Penrith. As part of this work, there will be traffic changes to the M4 Motorway Westbound on ramp.

What are we doing?

We will temporarily close the M4 westbound on-ramp on the nights of **Wednesday 2 February, Thursday 3 and Friday 4 February 2022** to undertake work including line removal and line marking, utility works, drainage, and general maintenance.

For the safety of road users and workers the closures will take place at night between **8pm and 5am**, weather permitting.

Should the work not proceed as listed above, the M4 westbound on ramp will be closed from 8pm to 5am on the nights of Monday 7 and Tuesday 8 February to carry out the work.

Traffic changes

There will be no access to the M4 westbound on ramp during this closure. Please view the map overleaf for the work location and detours.

To access the M4 Motorway westbound on ramp, detours will be via North Street, Jane Street and Mulgoa Road.

The Northern Road will remain open during this work and traffic control will be in place to assist road users. Local access to businesses and residents will be maintained.

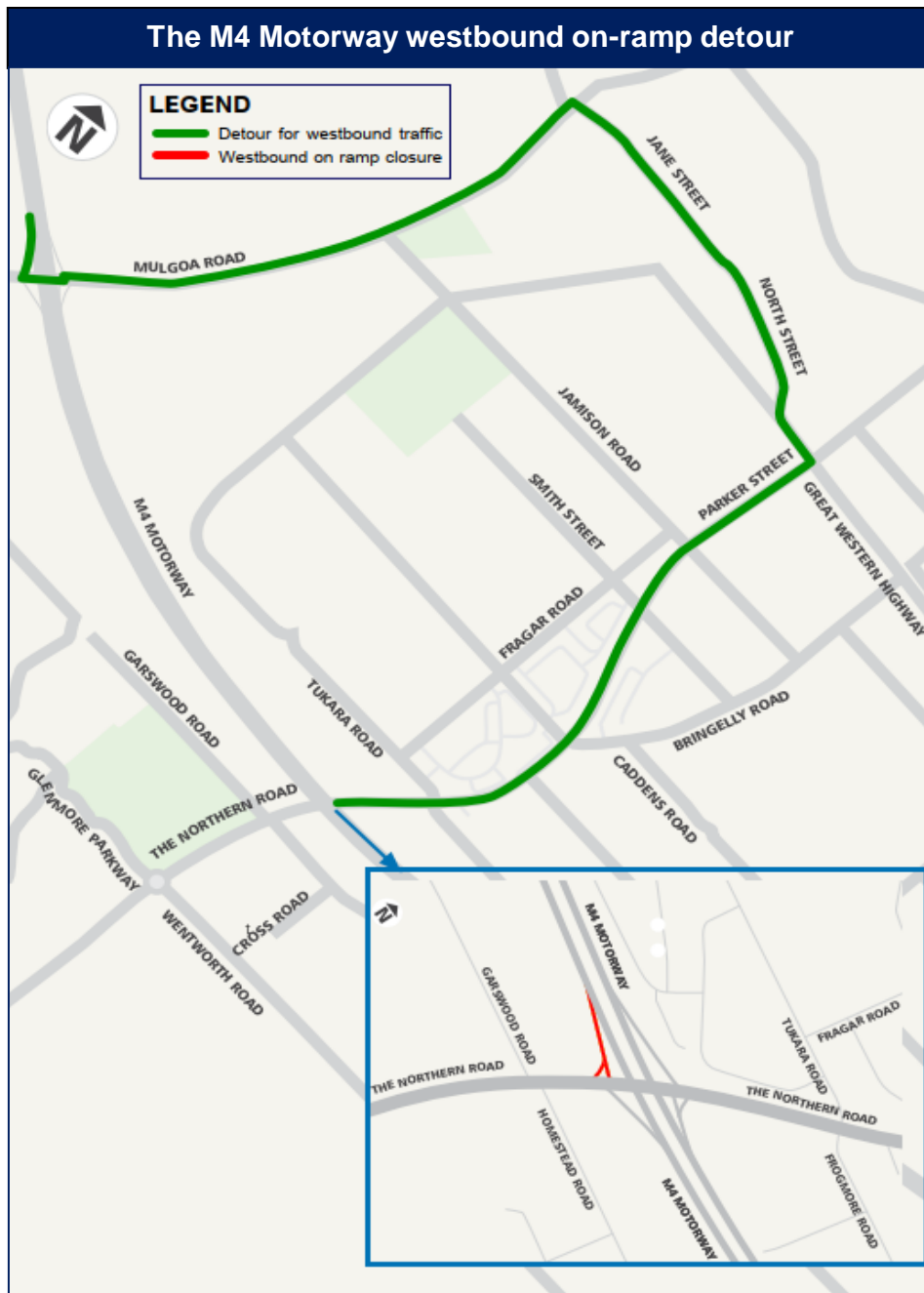
How this work will affect you?

During this work, every effort will be made to minimise the impacts to the community by:

- Using non-tonal reversing beepers on machinery
- Turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- Directing noise generating equipment away from properties where possible

What equipment will be used?

Construction machinery, light and heavy vehicles, lighting towers, power and hand tools.
