



Road closure at the M4 Motorway eastbound on ramp and Homestead Road

Transport for New South Wales is continuing work along The Northern Road between Glenmore Park and South Penrith. As part of these works, there will be traffic changes to the M4 Eastbound on ramp and Homestead Road.

What are we doing?

We will be temporarily closing the M4 eastbound on ramp and Homestead Road at The Northern Road intersection to undertake asphalt work (weather permitting).

For the safety of road users and workers the closures will take place at night on the following dates:

- M4 Eastbound on ramp from **8pm Friday 26 November to 5am Saturday 27 November and 8pm Saturday 27 November to 5am Sunday 28 November.**
- Homestead Road at The Northern Road intersection from **7pm Friday 3 December to 8pm Saturday 4 December.**

Should the work not proceed as listed above, the M4 Eastbound on ramp would be closed from 8pm Friday 3 December to 5am Saturday 4 December and 8pm Saturday 4 December to 5am Sunday 5 December, and Homestead Road will be closed from 7pm Friday 10 December to 8pm Saturday 11 December.

Traffic Closures

There will be no access to the M4 Eastbound on ramp and a section of Homestead Road during the closures. Please view the map overleaf for work locations and detours. The detours are as follows:

- M4 eastbound is via Great Western Highway and Gipps Street
- Homestead Road is via Cross Road and Wentworth Road.

How this work will affect you?

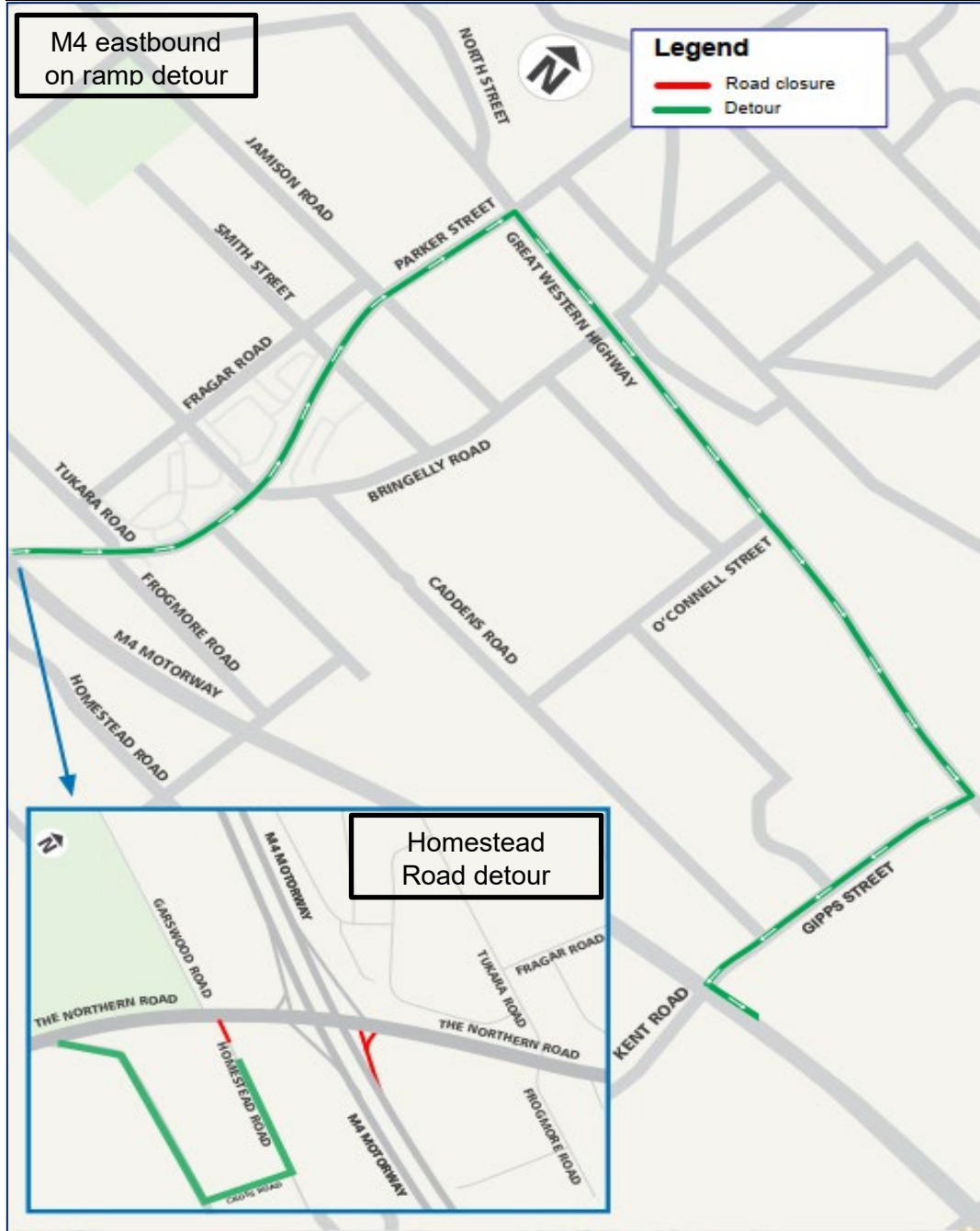
During our work, every effort will be made to minimize the impacts to the community by:

- using non-tonal reversing beepers on machinery
- turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- using lighting towers
- directing noise generating equipment away from properties.

What equipment will be using?

Asphalting machines, construction machinery, light and heavy vehicles, lighting towers, power and hand tools.
