Road closure at the M4 Motorway eastbound on ramp

Transport for New South Wales is finalising work along The Northern Road between Glenmore Park and South Penrith. As part of these works, there will be traffic changes to the M4 Motorway Eastbound on ramp.

What are we doing?

We will be temporarily closing the M4 eastbound on ramp between **Monday 17 and Friday 21 January 2022** to carry out maintenance and line marking work.

For the safety of road users and workers the closures will take place at night between **8pm and 5am**, weather permitting.

Should the work not proceed as listed above, the M4 eastbound on ramp will be closed from 8pm to 5am between Monday 31 January and Friday 4 February to carry out the work.

Traffic Closures

There will be no access to the M4 Motorway eastbound on ramp during the closure. Please view the map overleaf for the work location and detours.

To access the M4 Motorway eastbound detours will be via the Great Western Highway and Gipps Street.

Traffic control and electronic signage will be in place to assist road users and pedestrians.

How this work will affect you?

During our work, every effort will be made to minimise the impacts to the community by:

- using non-tonal reversing beepers on machinery
- turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- using lighting towers
- directing noise generating equipment away from properties.

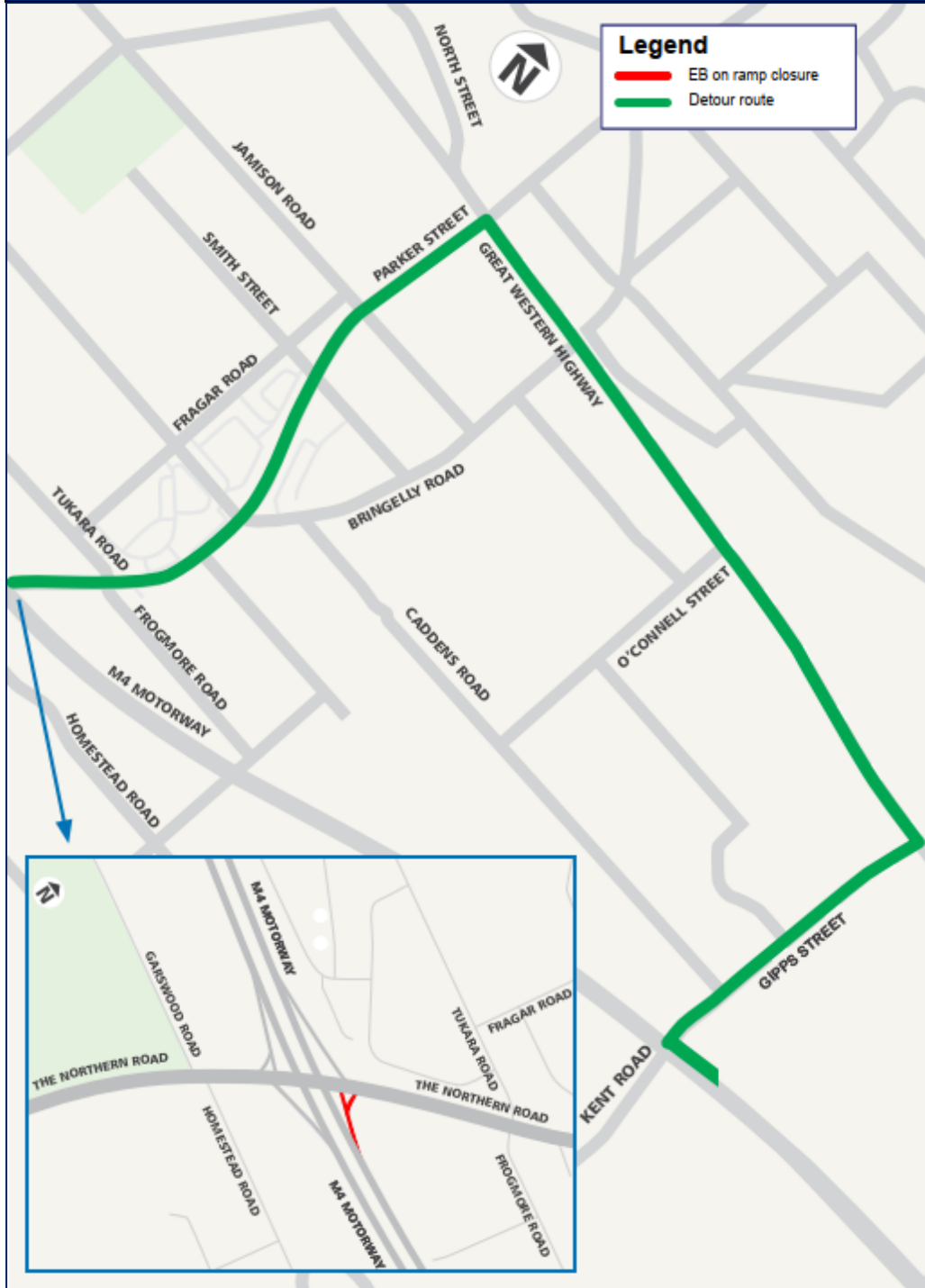
What equipment will be using?

Construction machinery, light and heavy vehicles, lighting towers, power and hand tools.
