Change of date

Traffic changes and road closures on The Northern Road, South Penrith from Saturday 27 June

The Australian and NSW Governments are jointly funding this work as part of the \$1.6 billion upgrade of The Northern Road between Narellan and South Penrith.

Transport for NSW is continuing work along The Northern Road between Glenmore Park and South Penrith. We are continuing to work hard to open the upgraded road to traffic later this year.

On **Saturday 27 June**, The Northern Road between the Maxwell Street / Bringelly Road intersection and Derby Street will be closed overnight from **9pm Saturday 27 June** to **9am Sunday 28 June 2020**, weather permitting.

There will be no access to The Northern Road from Jamison Road, Smith Street, Stafford Street and Derby Street during this shift. Detours will be in place via Maxwell Street and Fragar Road to access Smith Street and Jamison Road west. Access to Smith Street and Jamison Road to the east of The Northern Road will be via Bringelly Road and Derby Street.



27 June to 30 September road closures and traffic changes

Following the overnight closure, we will carry out work in this area during our standard construction hours **Mondays** to **Fridays** from **7am** to **6pm**, weather permitting. We may also need to continue working in this area at night to minimise disruption to the road network.

If we need to work at night, we will work for no more than **three nights a week**. We will notify you in advance if this is required. Our night work hours would be from **9pm** to **5am** on **weekdays** and **9pm** to **9am** on **Saturdays** and **Sundays**.

The following traffic changes will be in place from Sunday 27 June:

- The Northern Road between the Maxwell Street / Bringelly Road intersection and Jamison Road will be re-opened with two lanes in each direction
- the traffic lights at the intersection of The Northern Road and Smith Street will remain temporarily switched off. We will notify you when the traffic lights will become operational
- access to and from Smith Street will remain left in and left out only
- pedestrian access on The Northern Road at the Smith Street intersection will be maintained.

How will the work affect you?

During our work, you may also experience some noise and extra light and every effort will be made to minimise the impacts by:

- using non-tonal reversing beepers on machinery
- turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- using lighting towers only when necessary
- directing noise generating equipment away from resident properties where possible.

Plant and equipment

The project team will use heavy and light vehicles, lighting towers, and power and hand tools.

Traffic control and electronic message signs will be in place to direct road users through these changes.
