



Night work and west facing ramp closures on the M4 Motorway at The Northern Road from Friday 3 July

The Australian and NSW Governments are jointly funding this work as part of the \$1.6 billion upgrade of The Northern Road between Narellan and South Penrith.

Transport for NSW is continuing work along The Northern Road between Glenmore Park and South Penrith. Further work is required on the M4 Motorway ramps as part of the upgrade. Some of this work will take place at night to minimise the impact on traffic and improve safety for workers and motorists.



Upcoming work and ramp closures

We will temporarily close the M4 Motorway westbound on ramp and eastbound off ramp at The Northern Road interchange at the same time for key work including asphaltting and installing barriers on the new ramps. To minimise impact on road users, we will carry out this work over four weekend night shifts between **Friday 3 July** and **9am Sunday 16 August**, weather permitting.

We will only be working **Fridays** and **Saturdays** and our night work hours will be from **8pm to 8am**.

Traffic changes

Temporary traffic changes will be in place to ensure the work zone is safe for workers and road users. Electronic message signs will also be in place to direct roads users through these changes.

When travelling **westbound** (see *map – westbound detour 1*), detours will be in place for road users looking to enter the M4 Motorway westbound, to use The Northern Road/Parker Street, North Street/Jane Street, then use Mulgoa Road to access the M4 Motorway westbound on ramp on Mulgoa Road.

When travelling **eastbound** (see *map – eastbound detour 2*), detours will be in place for road users travelling eastbound on the M4 Motorway, to exit at Mulgoa Road, then use Jane Street/North Street to return to Parker Street/The Northern Road.

How will the work affect you?

During our work, you may experience some noise and extra light and every effort will be made to minimise the impacts by:

- using non-tonal reversing beepers on machinery
- turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- using lighting towers only when necessary
- directing noise generating equipment away from resident properties where possible.

Plant and equipment

The project team will use heavy and light vehicles, lighting towers, and power and hand tools.
