# The Northern Road Upgrade Stage 3

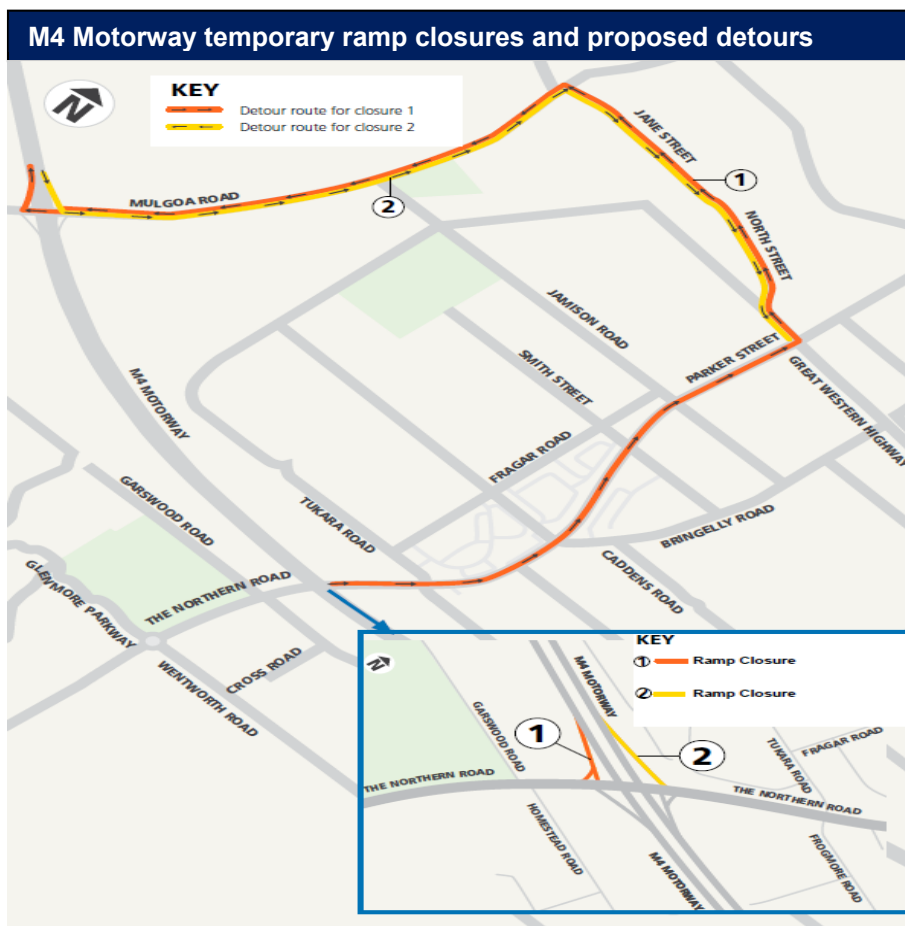
## Upcoming traffic changes in South Penrith from Saturday 18 April

The Australian and NSW Governments are jointly funding this work as part of the \$1.6 billion upgrade of The Northern Road between Narellan and South Penrith.

Transport for NSW is continuing work along The Northern Road between Glenmore Park and South Penrith. With less people driving on the roads during this unprecedented time, we will implement some traffic changes over the coming weeks, to take advantage of the lower traffic volumes, and carry out important work on the project.

### M4 Motorway temporary ramp closures

To progress important work on the M4 Motorway ramps, we will temporarily close the west facing ramps at The Northern Road and M4 Motorway interchange. We will carry out this work during two upcoming consecutive weekends.



We have spread this work over two weekends and will only close one of the ramps each weekend to help limit any disruption and additional congestion on the local road network.

### Week 1 - Westbound on ramp closure

We will close the westbound on ramp from **8pm Friday 24 April** to **5am Monday 27 April**, weather permitting.

When the **westbound on ramp** is closed, (see map – closure 1), detours will be in place for road users looking to enter the M4 Motorway westbound, to use The Northern Road, Parker Street, North Street/Jane Street, then use Mulgoa Road to access the M4 Motorway westbound on ramp on Mulgoa Road.

### Week 2 - Eastbound off ramp closure

We will close the eastbound off ramp from **8pm Friday 1 May** to **5am Monday 4 May**, weather permitting.

When the **eastbound off ramp** is closed (see map – closure 2), detours will be in place for road users travelling eastbound on the M4 Motorway, to exit at Mulgoa Road, then use Jane Street/North Street to return to The Northern Road.

## Temporary southbound lane closure

We will also take advantage of the low traffic volumes in the area and close a single southbound lane of The Northern Road between **Jamison Road** and **Bringelly Road**

This lane closure will be in place from **Saturday 18 April** and will be in place for **six weeks**. There will still be a single southbound lane open in this section during this time for all road users. We will ensure we closely monitor traffic in the area during this closure and adjust if necessary.

Temporary traffic changes will be in place to ensure the work zone is safe for workers and road users. Traffic control and electronic message signs will also be in place to direct road users through these changes.



## How will the work affect you?

During our work, you may experience some noise and extra light and every effort will be made to minimise the impacts by:

- using non-tonal reversing beepers on machinery
- turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- using lighting towers only when necessary
- directing noise generating equipment away from resident properties where possible.

## Plant and equipment

The project team will use heavy and light vehicles, lighting towers, and power and hand tools.
