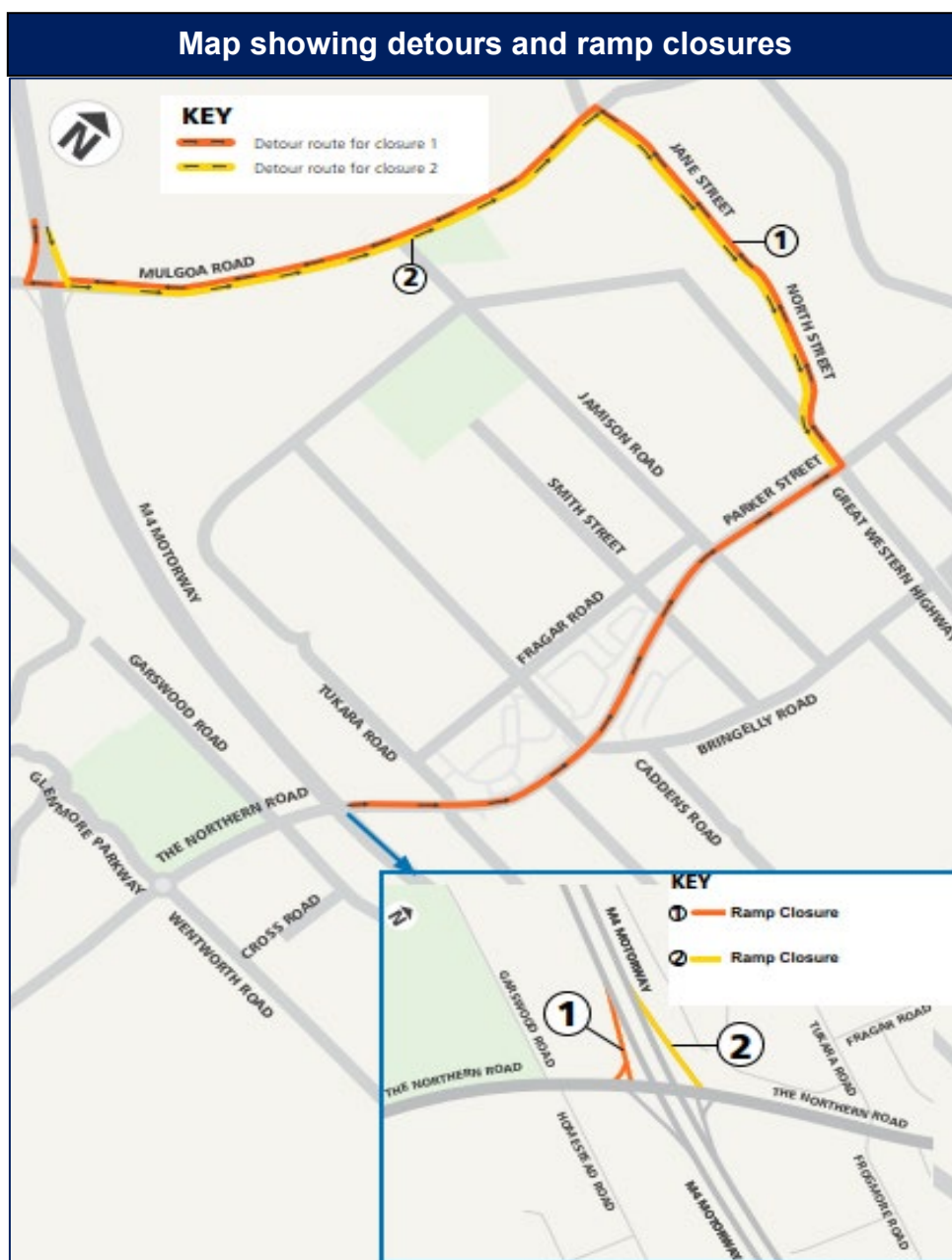

Night work and ramp closures on the M4 Motorway westbound at The Northern Road from Friday 28 February

The Australian and NSW Governments are jointly funding this work as part of the \$1.6 billion upgrade of The Northern Road between Narellan and South Penrith.

Transport for NSW is continuing work along The Northern Road between Glenmore Park and South Penrith. Further work is required on the M4 Motorway ramps as part of the upgrade. Some of this work will take place at night to minimise the impact on traffic and improve safety for workers and motorists.



Upcoming work and ramp closures

We will temporarily close the westbound on ramp for the M4 Motorway and the eastbound on ramp at the M4 Motorway for key work on the new ramps. To minimise impact on road users, we will carry out this work over several night shifts from **Friday 28 February to Sunday 12 April 2020**.

Our night work hours will be from **10pm to 8am Friday, 10pm to 8am Saturday and 10pm to 5am Sunday**, weather permitting. We will work no more than **three nights a week** in this location.

Traffic changes

Temporary traffic changes will be in place to ensure the work one is safe for workers and road users. Electronic message signs will also be in place to direct road users through these changes.

When the **westbound on ramp** is closed (*see map – closure 1*), detours will be in place via The Northern Road, Parker Street, North Street/Jane Street and Mulgoa Road to access the M4 Motorway westbound.

When the **eastbound off ramp** is closed (*see map – closure 2*), detours will be in place via Mulgoa Road and North Street/Jane Street to exit the M4 Motorway eastbound.

Both ramps will be closed simultaneously.

During this time, there will be traffic changes which will be managed by traffic control and electronic message signs to direct road users safely on and off the M4 Motorway.

How will the work affect you?

During our work, you may experience some noise and extra light and every effort will be made to minimise the impacts by:

- using non-tonal reversing beepers on machinery
- turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- using lighting towers only when necessary
- directing noise generating equipment away from resident properties where possible.

Plant and equipment

The project team will use heavy and light vehicles, lighting towers, and power and hand tools.
