Night time ramp closure on the M4 Motorway at The Northern Road on Tuesday 30 March and Wednesday 31 March

The Australian and NSW Governments are jointly funding this work as part of the \$1.6 billion upgrade of The Northern Road between Narellan and South Penrith.

Transport for NSW is continuing work along The Northern Road between Glenmore Park and South Penrith.

Due to the impact of the recent flood events, we have postponed plans to close The Northern Road between Maxwell Street and Jamison Road over the coming weekend. This will help to minimise disruption for residents and road users and ensure full access is available for flood clean up activities.

M4 Motorway temporary ramp closures

Next week there will be some overnight closures of the westbound on ramp and the eastbound off ramp from The Northern Road to the M4 Motorway. These will be night closures on **Tuesday 30** and **Wednesday 31 March** to allow work to install signage infrastructure and carry out asphaltting.



During this work the westbound on ramp from The Northern Road to the M4 Motorway and the eastbound off ramp from the M4 Motorway to The Northern Road will be closed from **7pm Tuesday 30 March to 5am Wednesday 31 March**, and **7pm Wednesday 31 March to 5am Thursday 1 April**, weather permitting. Road users will be advised using electronic message signs in the area.

When the ramp is closed, detours will be in place to enter and exit the M4 Motorway via Mulgoa Road.

Traffic changes

Temporary traffic changes will be in place to ensure the work zone is safe for workers and road users. Traffic control and electronic message signs will also be in place to direct road users through these changes

How will the work affect you?

During our work, you may experience some noise and extra light and every effort will be made to minimise the impacts by:

- using non-tonal reversing beepers on machinery
- turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- using lighting towers only when necessary
- directing noise generating equipment away from resident properties where possible.

Plant and equipment

The project team will use heavy and light vehicles, lighting towers, and power and hand tools.
