## **Night works at Tukara Road and Frogmore Road intersections on Friday 21 and Saturday 22 May**

The Australian and NSW Governments are jointly funding this work as part of the \$1.6 billion upgrade of The Northern Road between Narellan and South Penrith.

Transport for New South Wales is continuing works along The Northern Road between Glenmore Park and South Penrith. As part of these works, there will be traffic changes at the intersections of Tukara Road and Frogmore Road.

### **What we are doing**

As part of works to The Northern Road we will be asphaltting the intersections of Tukara Road and Frogmore Road.

For the safety of road users and workers, there will be no access from The Northern Road to or from Tukara Road and Frogmore Road from:

- **8pm Friday 21 May to 8am Saturday 22 May**
- **8pm Saturday 22 May to 8am Sunday 23 May.**

### **Traffic Changes**

Please see the map overleaf to better explain the location of this work and the detours in place.

Detours are as follows:

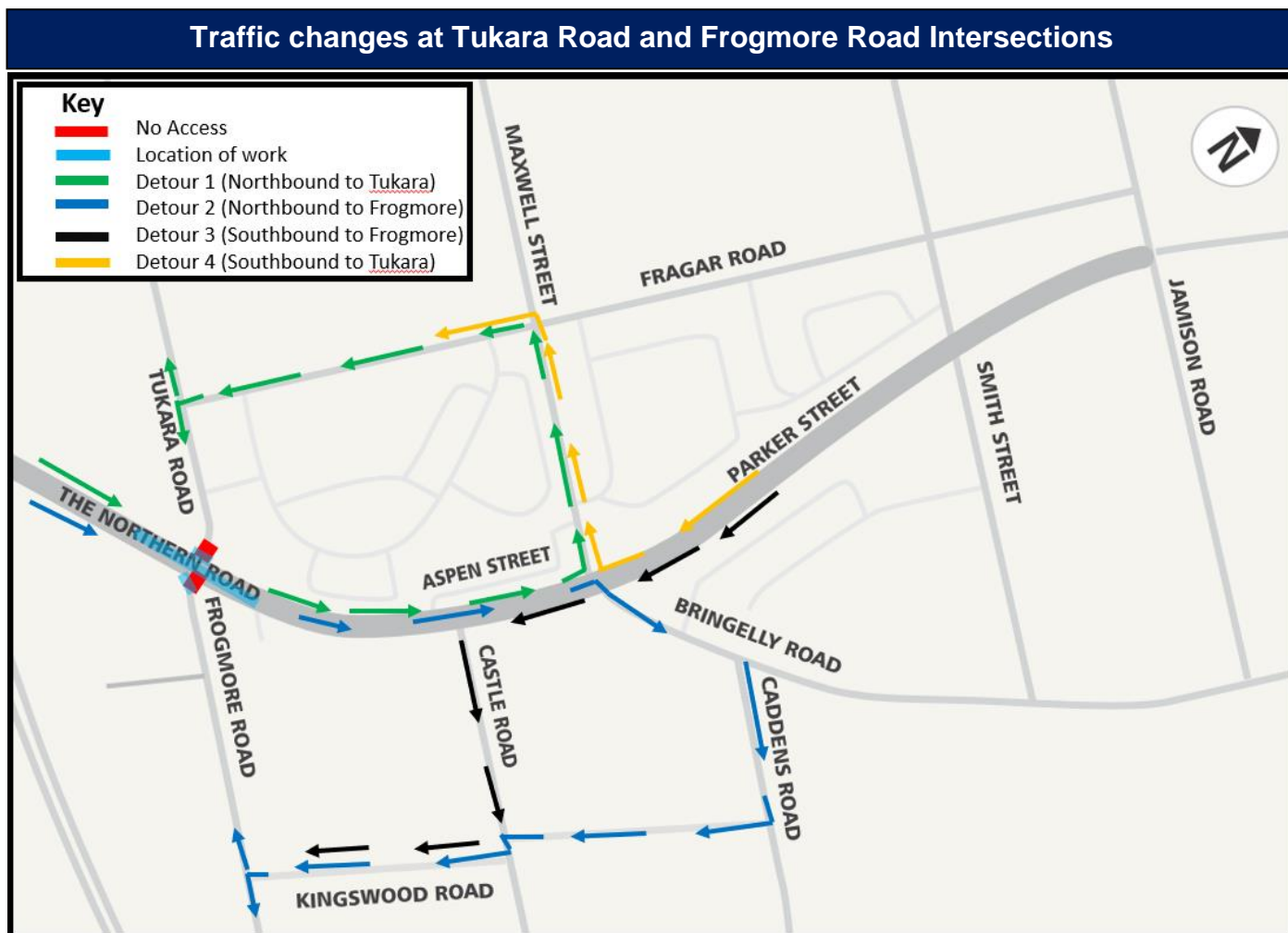
- To access Tukara Road: northbound, use Maxwell Street and Fragar Road (Detour 1), or southbound, use Maxwell Street and Fragar Road (Detour 4).
- To access Frogmore Road: northbound, use Bringelly Road, Caddens Road and Kingswood Road (Detour 2), or southbound use Castle Road and Kingswood Road (Detour 4).

Road users will be advised using electronic message signs in the area.

## How this work will affect you

During our work, every effort will be made to minimize the impacts to the community by:

- using non-tonal reversing beepers on machinery
- turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- using lighting towers (only when necessary)
- directing noise generating equipment away from properties where possible.
