



Work starting on Glenmore Parkway U-turn bay from Wednesday 23 June 2021

The Australian and NSW governments are delivering the \$1.6 billion The Northern Road upgrade between Narellan and South Penrith.

Earlier this year, Transport for NSW invited feedback on the construction of a U-turn bay along Glenmore Parkway instead of the originally proposed roundabout.

Following consultation, Transport for NSW has amended the original proposal and a decision has been made to proceed with the construction of a U-turn bay. The design and location of the U-turn bay is shown below.

The implementation of the U-turn bay will:

- Enable road users travelling east on Glenmore Parkway to make a U-turn prior to reaching The Northern Road and travel west back towards the Glenmore Park town centre
- Maintain traffic flow along Glenmore Parkway
- Reduce the duration and impact of construction on the local community
- Minimise traffic impacts during construction including the number of closures of Glenmore Parkway between The Northern Road and St Andrews Drive.

We thank everyone who took part in the consultation process and provided feedback.

Schedule of work

Work is scheduled to begin from **Wednesday 23 June 2021** and is expected to be complete in the third quarter of 2021.

Work will generally take place during standard construction hours which are **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday, and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays**. Due to Covid-19, we are also allowed to work extended hours on **Saturdays** from **7am to 6pm**, and on **Sundays and public holidays** from **7am to 6pm** if needed.

To ensure the safety of workers and motorists and to minimise the disruption to the road network, we will need to undertake some work outside of standard construction hours. Directly impacted residents and businesses will be notified in advance of these works taking place.

Traffic changes

During this work there may be some temporary traffic changes along Glenmore Parkway to ensure the work zone is safe for workers and motorists.

What are we doing?

Work to construct the Glenmore Parkway U-turn bay will include:

- Asphalt paving and line marking
- Installation of street signs and lighting
- Earthworks, drainage and kerb installation
- Vegetation removal and landscaping.

How will the work affect you?

The work may be noisy at times, but we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including:

- Using non-tonal reversing beepers on machinery
- Turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- Using lighting towers only when necessary
- Directing noise generating equipment away from properties where possible.
