Weekend work at the intersection of The Northern Road and Jamison Road – 28 to 30 May and 4 to 5 June 2021

The Australian and NSW Governments are jointly funding this work as part of the \$1.6 billion upgrade of The Northern Road between Narellan and South Penrith.

Transport for New South Wales is continuing works along The Northern Road between Glenmore Park and South Penrith. As part of these works, there will be traffic changes at The Northern Road and Jamison Road intersection.

What we are doing?

We will be temporarily closing Jamison Road at the intersection with The Northern Road to undertake drainage and final road works including asphaltting.

During the day, lane closures will also be in place on Jamison Road and The Northern Road.

For the safety of road users and workers, the following traffic changes will be in place:

Night work (closure of Jamison Road at The Northern Road)

- 8pm Friday 28 May to 8am Saturday 29 May
- 8pm Saturday 29 May to 8am Sunday 30 May
- 8pm Friday 4 June to 8am Saturday 5 June
- 8pm Saturday 5 June to 8am Sunday 6 June

Day work (lane closures on Jamison Road and The Northern Road)

- 7am to 5pm on Friday 28 May, Saturday 29 May and Sunday 30 May
- 7am to 5pm on Friday 4 June, Saturday 5 June and Sunday 6 June

Traffic changes

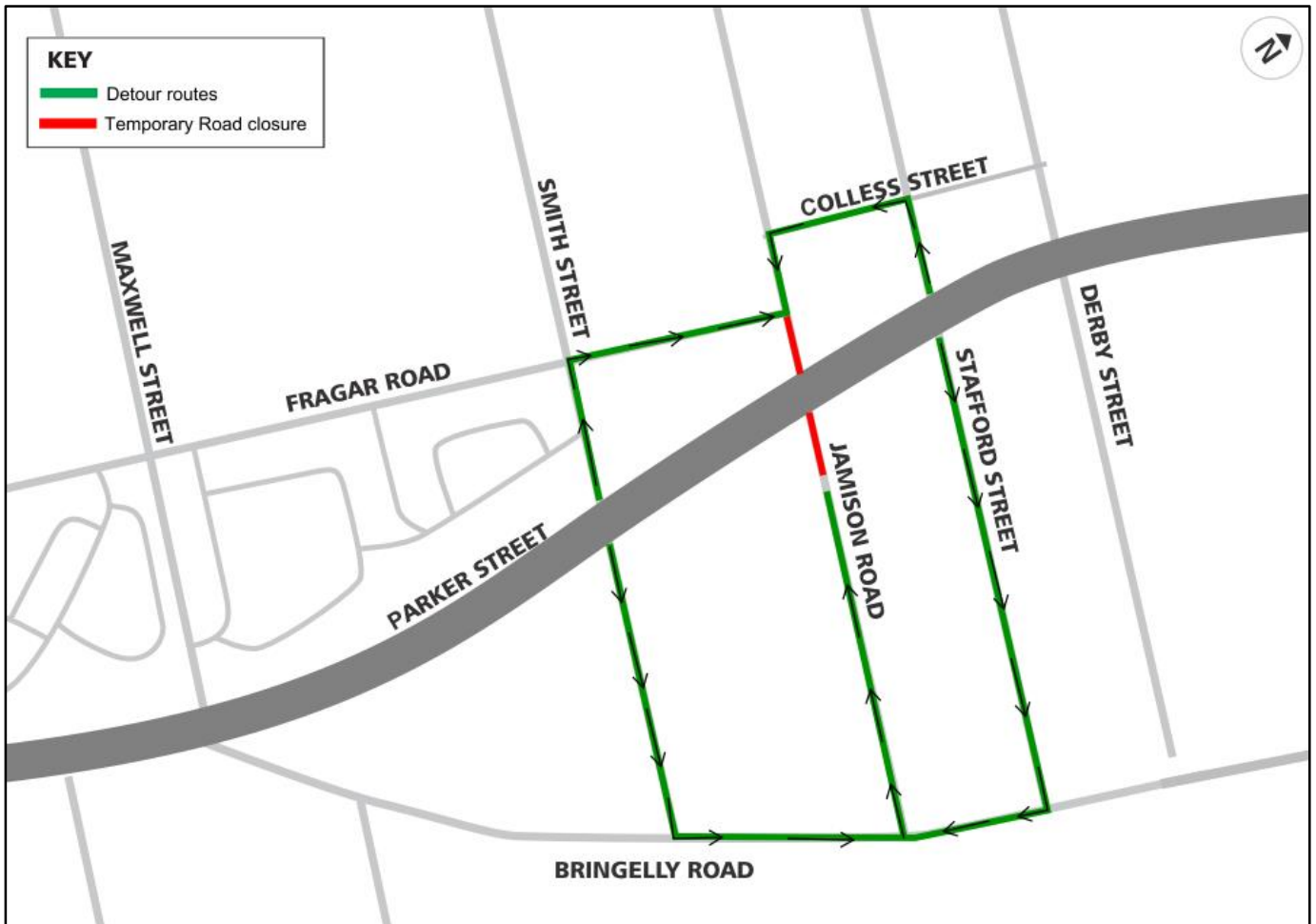
Please see the map overleaf to better explain the location of this work and the detours in place for night work.

The following detours will be in place during the above times:

- Access to Jamison Road west will be via Smith Street and Fragar Road, or Stafford Street and Colless Street.
- Access Jamison Road east will be via Smith Street and Bringelly Road, or Stafford Street and Bringelly Road.

The Northern Road will remain open during this work and traffic control will be in place to assist road users.

What equipment will be used?

Asphalting machines, construction machinery, light and heavy vehicles, lighting towers, power and hand tools.

How this work will affect you?

During our work, every effort will be made to minimize the impacts to the community by:

- using non-tonal reversing beepers on machinery
- turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- using lighting towers
- directing noise generating equipment away from properties where possible.
