

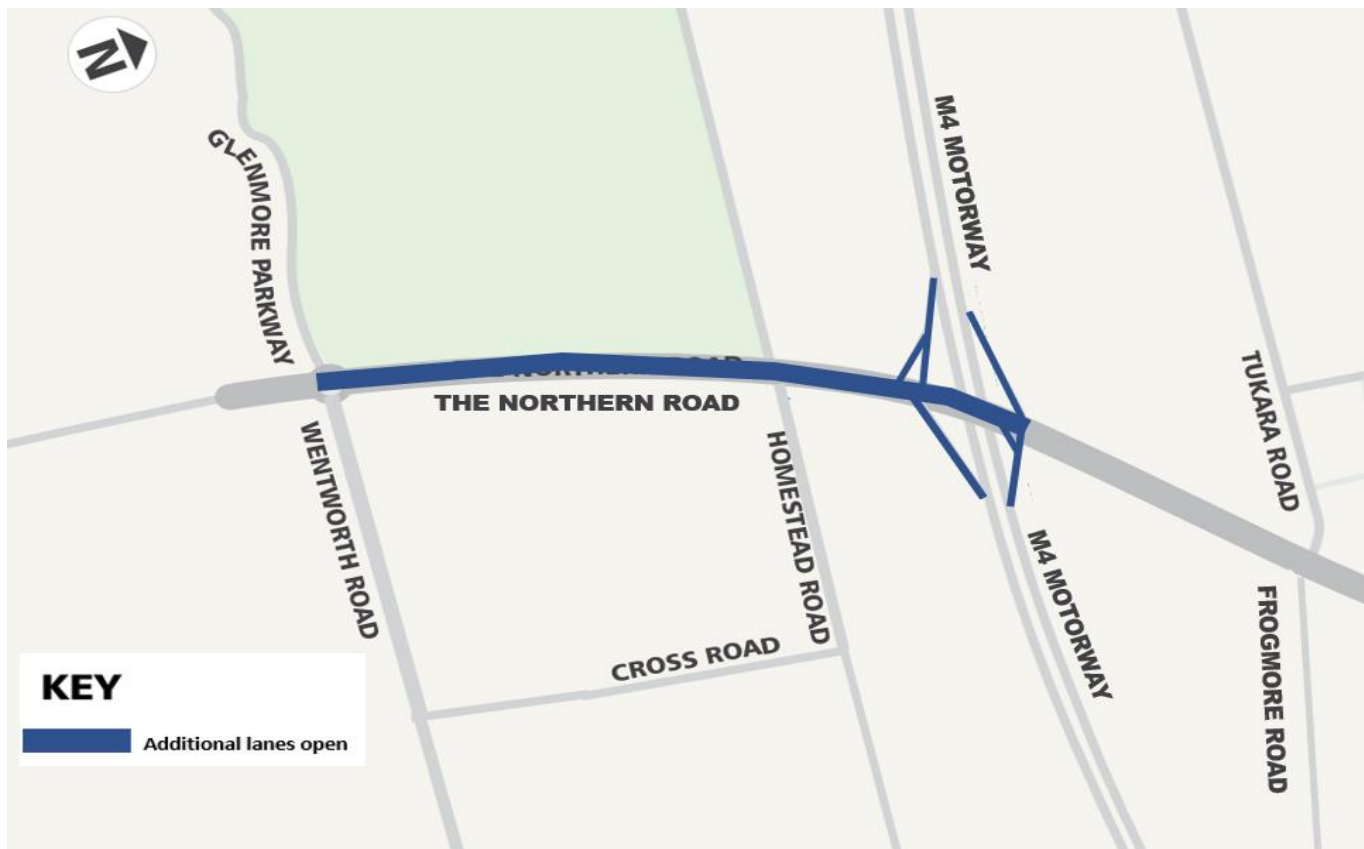


# Changes in lane configuration on The Northern Road between Glenmore Parkway and the M4 Motorway from Wednesday 28 April 2021

The Australian and NSW Governments are jointly funding this work as part of the \$1.6 billion upgrade of The Northern Road between Narellan and South Penrith.

Transport for New South Wales is continuing works along The Northern Road between Glenmore Park and South Penrith. On **Wednesday 28 April between 7am and 6pm**, we will be opening additional lanes to traffic on the M4 Motorway ramps and The Northern Road in both directions.

## What are we doing?

At the completion of these works, the following will be in place along this section:

- Four lanes northbound and southbound will be opened, including the designated bus lanes
- All traffic lanes on the M4 Motorway ramps will be open.

## How will the work affect you?

Residents close to the work zone may experience some noise and every effort will be made to minimise the impacts by:

- using non-tonal reversing beepers on machinery
- turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- directing lighting towers away from properties where possible
- directing noise generating equipment away from properties where possible.

## Plant and equipment

We will use heavy and light vehicles, lighting towers, and power and hand tools.
