



Local road closures on Maxwell Street and Bringelly Road

Transport for New South Wales is continuing works along The Northern Road between Glenmore Park and South Penrith. As part of these works, there will be traffic changes at the intersection of Maxwell Street, Bringelly Road and The Northern Road.

What we are doing?

We will be temporarily closing sections of Maxwell Street, Bringelly Road, Aspen Street and Hilliger Road to complete asphaltting.

For the safety of road users and workers, the following intersection closures will be in place:

- The Northern Road, Maxwell Street and Bringelly Road
- Hilliger Road and Maxwell Street
- Aspen Street and Maxwell Street.

The road closures will be in place from **8pm Tuesday 1 June to 5am Wednesday 2 June** and **8pm Wednesday 2 June to 5am Thursday 3 June** with 8pm Tuesday 8 June to 5am Wednesday 9 June as a contingency date.

Traffic Changes

Please see the map overleaf to better explain the location of the work and the preferred detours in place. During this work:

- Access to Maxwell Street will be via Smith Street or Jamison Road and Fragar Road.
- Access to Bringelly Road will be via Smith Street
- Access to Aspen Street will be via The Northern Road.

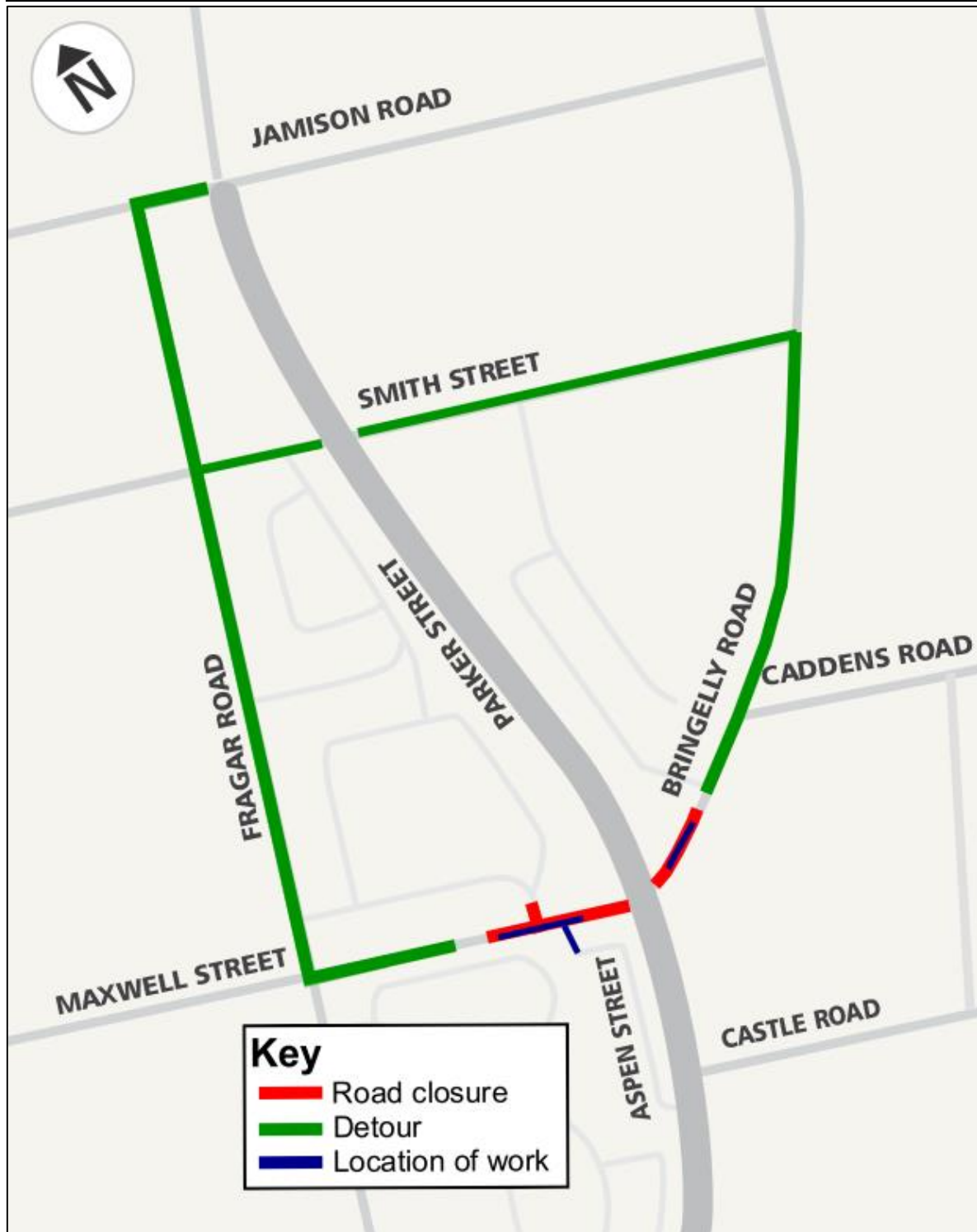
Electronic signage will be in place to assist road users in the area during this work.

How this work will affect you?

During our work, every effort will be made to minimize the impacts to the community by:

- using non-tonal reversing beepers on machinery
- turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- using lighting towers only when necessary
- directing noise generating equipment away from properties where possible.
