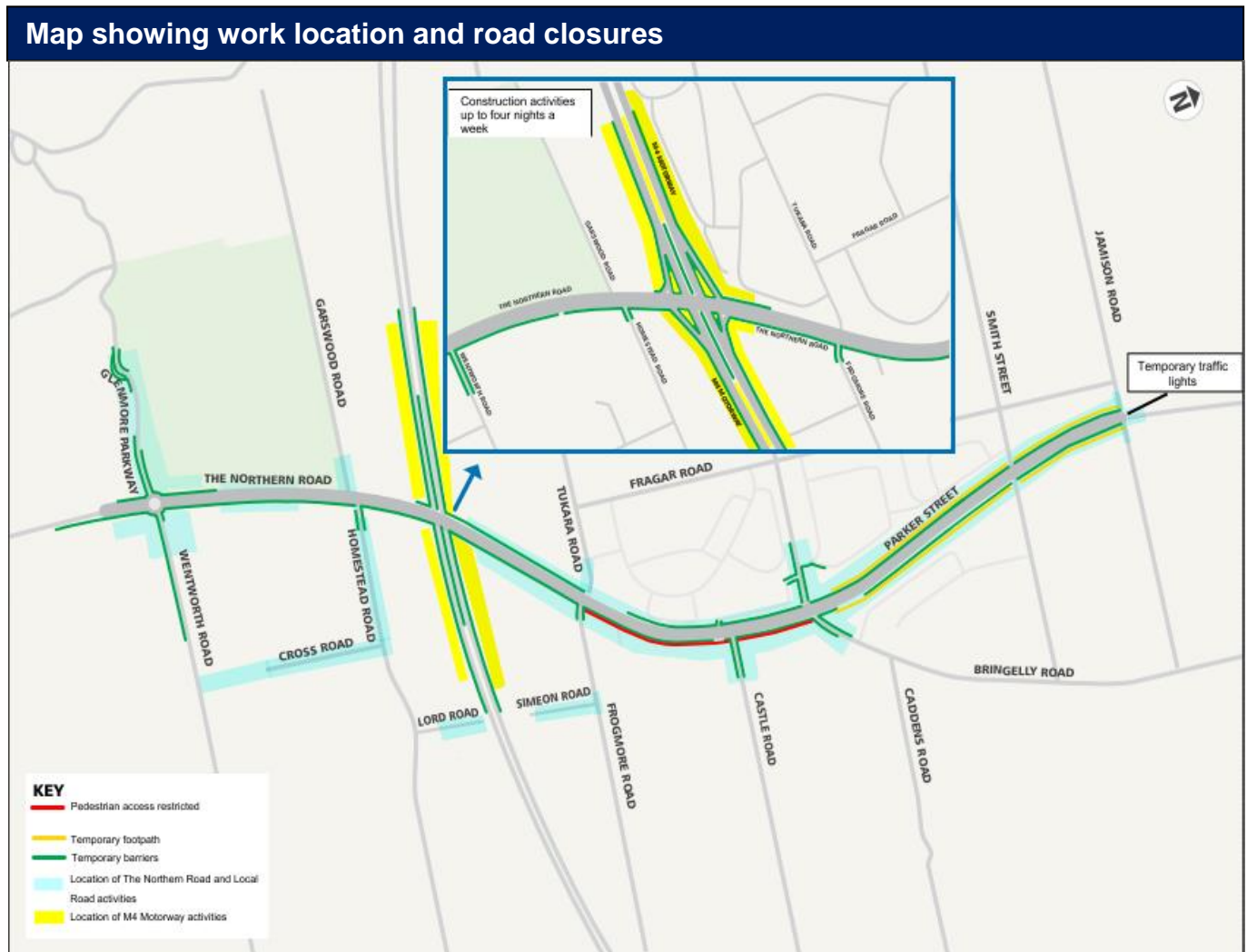




Night work continuing on The Northern Road, South Penrith from Tuesday 6 April

The Australian and NSW Governments are jointly funding this work as part of the \$1.6 billion upgrade of The Northern Road between Narellan and South Penrith.

As part of The Northern Road upgrade between Glenmore Parkway and South Penrith, Transport for NSW will carry out additional night work along The Northern Road, local side streets, the M4 Motorway and interchange in the lead up to the completion of the project.



Our work

To minimise the impact on road users, we will need to carry out work at night between **Tuesday 6 April 2021** and **Sunday 27 June 2021**, weather permitting. Our work hours will be from **9pm to 9am** on **weekends** and from **9pm to 5am weekdays**.

There will be up to **five night shifts per week**, with no more than **three** consecutive night shifts carried out in the same location. Directly impacted residents will be notified before work starts.

This work will involve:

- building retaining walls
- installing temporary access ramps and concrete platforms
- utility work including cutovers and removing overhead cables
- installing drainage
- setting up and adjusting barriers and signage
- installing temporary lanes, asphaltting, building road surface layers and line marking
- landscaping.

What to expect

Some activities may be noisy. The project team will limit these impacts wherever possible. Every effort will be made to minimise noise impact on residents by:

- using non-tonal reversing beepers on machinery
- turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- using lighting towers only when necessary
- directing noise generating equipment away from resident properties where possible.

Traffic changes

For the safety of road users and workers, most of the work will take place behind concrete barriers. There will be some traffic changes and temporary lane and road closures which may affect travel times. Detours will be in place which may affect travel times. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of signs and traffic controllers.

Electronic message signs will also be in place to direct road users through these changes. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs. For the latest traffic updates, you can call 132 701, visit livetraffic.com or download the Live Traffic NSW App.
