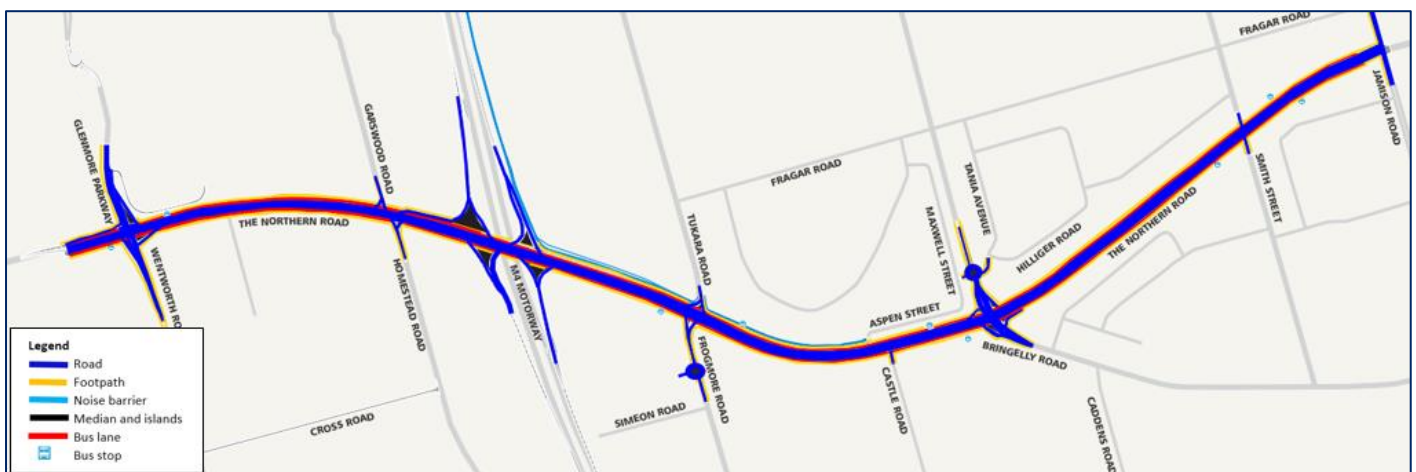

## Work continues on The Northern Road between Glenmore Parkway, Glenmore Park and Jamison Road, South Penrith

The Australian and NSW Governments are jointly funding this work as part of the \$1.6 billion upgrade of The Northern Road between Narellan and South Penrith.

Transport for NSW is continuing work on The Northern Road upgrade **from October to December 2021**. Work will take place along The Northern Road, local side streets, and the M4 Western Motorway including on and off ramps. Once completed, the upgrade will reduce congestion, providing faster more reliable journeys for motorists and the community.



### Milestones

Over the last few months, the team has achieved a number of project milestones including:

- Opening of the north and south bound bus lanes along The Northern Road
- Delivering local roads back to Penrith City Council
- Completion of the Maxwell Street works including a new roundabout at Aspen Street and Hilliger Road and the shared path connecting to The Northern Road
- Completion of a number of property adjustments along the project alignment

### COVID-19

All work on site is being carried out in line with the current public health orders and a COVID Safe plan is in place, including the use of QR codes.

## Upcoming work

In the coming months, works taking place will include:

- Final asphaltting and line marking along The Northern Road and local roads
- Minor utility and drainage work
- Construction of U-turn bay at Glenmore Parkway
- Completion of the shared pathways
- Ongoing property adjustments
- Landscaping.

We will provide further updates and information to any directly impacted residents and businesses before commencing work.

## Working hours

To support industry and continue the delivery of critical infrastructure during COVID-19, the NSW Government introduced rules allowing construction sites, including public infrastructure projects, to operate on weekends and public holidays.

Standard construction hours are now **Monday to Sunday, 7am to 6pm (inclusive of public holidays)**.

To ensure the safety of workers and motorists and to minimise disruption to the road network, we will need to undertake some work outside of standard construction hours. When work is to be carried out outside of standard construction hours, directly impacted residents and businesses will be notified.

## How will the work affect you?

There may be some noise associated with our work; however, we will make every effort to minimise noise by:

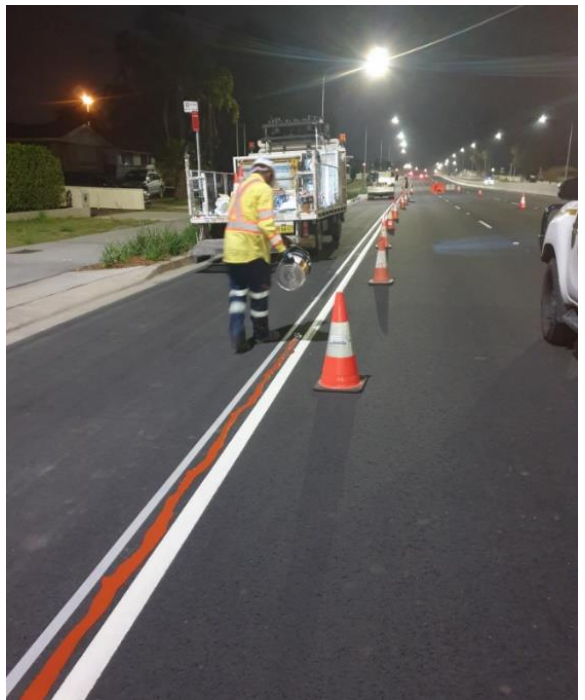
- Adapting construction methods to reduce noise impacts where possible
- Arranging work in stages at different locations
- Using non-tonal reversing beepers on machinery
- Turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- Directing noise generating equipment away from properties where possible.

## Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes to ensure the safety of workers and motorists. Please adhere to the displayed speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.
