Road closures on Tukara Road and Aspen Street – 7 June

The Australian and NSW Governments are jointly funding this work as part of the \$1.6 billion upgrade of The Northern Road between Narellan and South Penrith.

Transport for New South Wales is continuing works along The Northern Road between Glenmore Park and South Penrith. As part of these works, there will be traffic changes at The Northern Road intersections of Tukara Road and Aspen Street.

What we are doing?

We will be temporarily closing access to Tukara Road and Aspen Street from The Northern Road to complete asphaltting.

For the safety of road users and workers, the following intersection closures will be in place:

- The Northern Road and Tukara Road
- The Northern Road and Aspen Street.

The closures will be in place from **8pm Monday 7 June to 5am Tuesday 8 June**.

Traffic Changes

Please see the map overleaf which reflects the location of this work and the detours in place. During this work:

- Access to Tukara Road will be via Maxwell Street and Fragar Road.
- Access to Aspen Street will be via Maxwell Street

Electronic signage will be in place to assist road users in the area during this work.

How this work will affect you?

During our work, every effort will be made to minimize the impacts to the community by:

- Using non-tonal reversing beepers on machinery
- Turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- Using lighting towers only when necessary
- Directing noise generating equipment away from properties where possible.
