Work continues on The Northern Road between Glenmore Parkway, Glenmore Park and Jamison Road, South Penrith

The Australian and NSW Governments are jointly funding this work as part of the \$1.6 billion upgrade of The Northern Road between Narellan and South Penrith.

Transport for NSW is continuing work on The Northern Road upgrade **from June to September 2021**. Work will take place along The Northern Road, local side streets, and the M4 Western Motorway including on and off ramps. Once completed, the upgrade will reduce congestion, providing faster more reliable journeys for motorists and the community.

Milestones

Over the last few months, the team has achieved a number of project milestones including:

- Opening The Northern Road to traffic between Glenmore Parkway and Jamison Road. This includes three lanes and a bus lane in either direction between Glenmore Parkway and Smith Street.
- Switching to the new underground power supply and removal of redundant power poles.
- All new signalised intersections have been switched on
- Installation of all noise walls.
- Completion of the M4 interchange works.

We'd like to thank the local community and road users for their patience while we carry out this important work.

Upcoming work

In the coming months, works taking place will include:

- Final asphaltting and line marking along The Northern Road and local roads
- Minor utility and drainage work
- Completion of the shared pathways
- Ongoing property adjustments
- Landscaping.

We will provide further updates and information to any directly impacted residents and businesses before commencing work.



COVID-19

In line with current Australian Government guidelines around slowing the spread of Coronavirus and social distancing, all work on site is being carried out at a safe physical distance where possible, and necessary hygiene practices will continue to be observed.

Working hours

To support industry and continue the delivery of critical infrastructure during COVID-19, the NSW Government introduced rules allowing construction sites, including public infrastructure projects, to operate on weekends and public holidays.

Standard construction hours are now **Monday to Sunday, 7am to 6pm (inclusive of public holidays)**.

To ensure the safety of workers and motorists and to minimise disruption to the road network, we will need to undertake some work outside of standard construction hours. When work is to be carried out outside of standard construction hours, directly impacted residents and businesses will be notified.

How will the work affect you?

There may be some noise associated with our work; however, we will make every effort to minimise noise by:

- Adapting construction methods to reduce noise impacts where possible
- Arranging work in stages at different locations
- Using non-tonal reversing beepers on machinery
- Turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- Directing noise generating equipment away from properties where possible.

Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes to ensure the safety of workers and motorists. Please adhere to the displayed speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.
