Night work and traffic changes on The Northern Road upgrade, South Penrith from Friday 20 April 2018

The Australian and NSW governments are jointly funding this work as part of the \$1.6 billion upgrade of The Northern Road between Narellan and South Penrith.

Roads and Maritime Services is continuing work along The Northern Road between Glenmore Park and South Penrith.

As part of this work, water utilities will be installed along The Northern Road (Parker Street section) between Bringelly Road and Jamison Road, South Penrith.

To minimise the impact on motorists, work will be carried out over three nights between **7pm** and **7am** on **Friday 20 April, Saturday 21 April** and **Sunday 22 April 2018** weather permitting. The attached map shows the location of the traffic changes.

How will the work affect you?

We will be working along Parker Street and using the stockpile site at the corner of Maxwell Street and Parker Street, South Penrith.

Our work may be noisy but every effort will be made to minimise impacts on residents by:

- changing our construction methods to reduce night work impact as much as possible
- changing between work locations to minimise continuous impact on the same groups of residents
- using equipment fitted with noise mitigation devices and monitoring noise at night.

Traffic changes

Temporary traffic changes will be in place to ensure the work zone is safe for workers and road users.

Parker Street will be closed between Bringelly Road and Jamison Road and access to Smith Street restricted. Detours will be in place via Bringelly Road and Jamison Road. Resident access to Parker Street will be maintained via traffic control, located at Jamison Road and Maxwell Street.

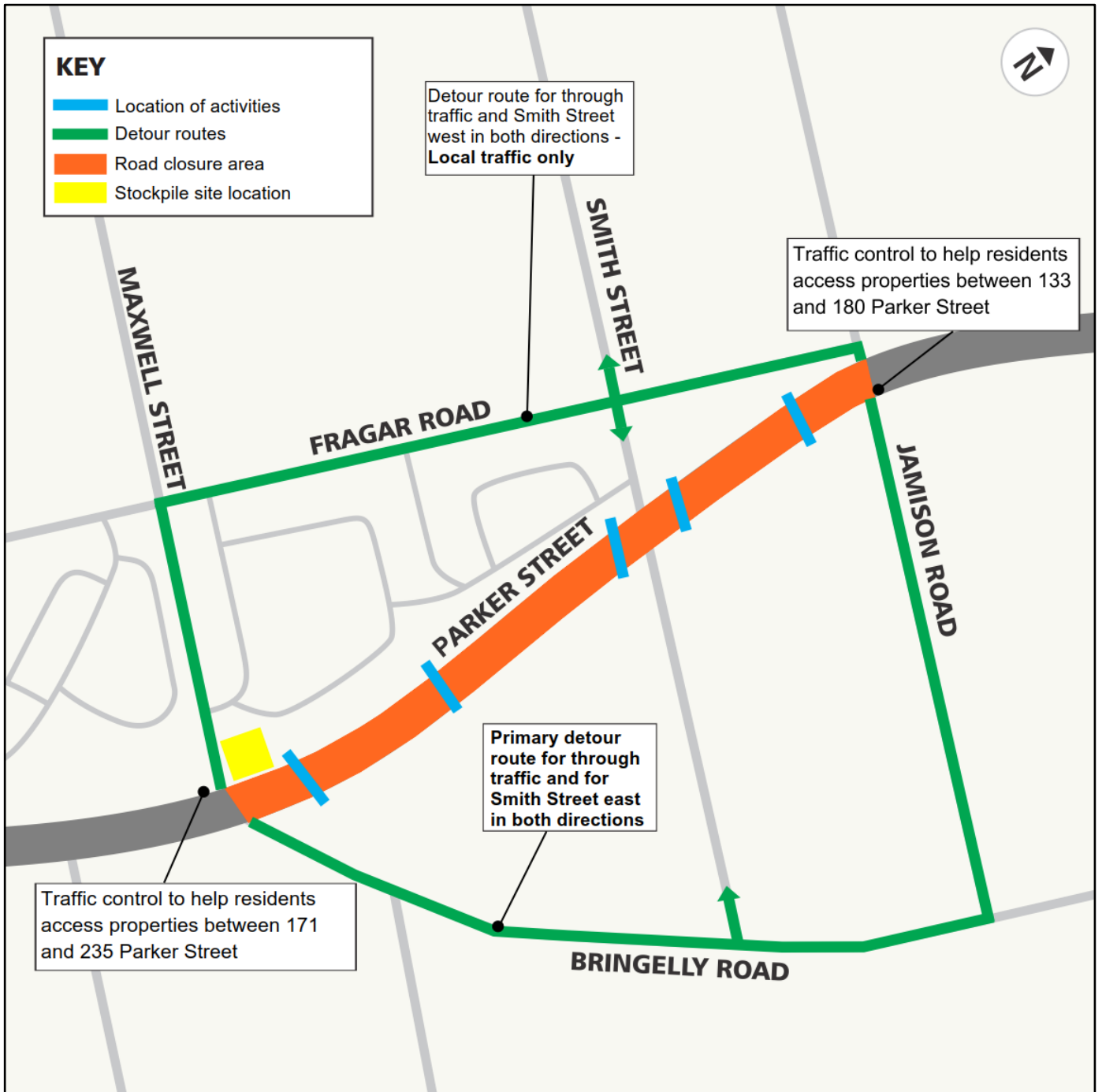
