Night work and traffic changes on The Northern Road, South Penrith from Tuesday 3 April

The Australian and NSW governments are jointly funding this work as part of the \$1.6 billion upgrade of The Northern Road between Narellan and South Penrith.

Roads and Maritime Services is continuing work on The Northern Road upgrade between Glenmore Parkway, Glenmore Park and Jamison Road, South Penrith.

Work includes clearing vegetation along Maxwell Street and Parker Street between Smith Street and Jamison Road, South Penrith.

We are carrying out this work at night to minimise traffic impact and improve safety for workers and motorists. The work will take place between **7pm** and **9am** on **Tuesday 3 April** and **Thursday 5 April 2018**, weather permitting.

We have attached a map to better show the location of the work.

How will the work affect you?

Our work may be noisy and will involve using chainsaws, excavators and, loading and unloading trucks.

Every effort will be made to minimise the impact on residents and businesses by:

- changing our construction methodology to reduce night work impact
- scheduling noisier activities in the earliest part of the shift, where possible
- alternating between work locations to minimise continuous impact on the same community
- using equipment fitted with noise mitigation devices
- monitoring noise at night.

Traffic changes

Temporary traffic changes will be in place to ensure the work zone is safe for workers and motorists.

Motorist travelling on The Northern Road between Castle Road and Smith Street may encounter temporary road closures where traffic will be stopped for periods of up to 10 minutes.

A contraflow arrangement will be in place during work on Parker Street between Smith Street and Jamison Road. Northbound and southbound motorists will be diverted onto the northbound traffic lanes while work is being carried out on the southbound lanes.

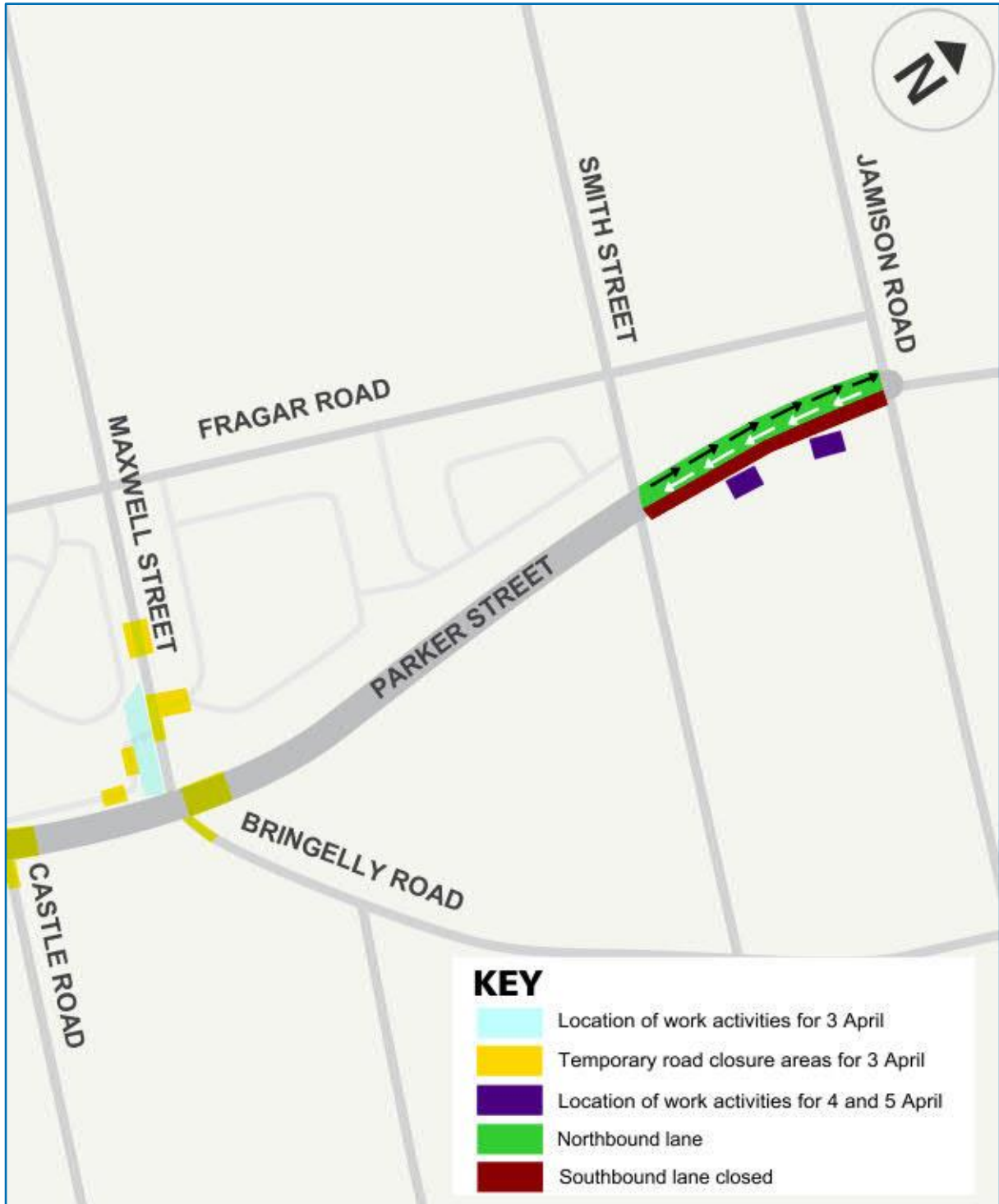
Electronic message signs will be in place to direct road users through these changes.
