Changes to Marlborough, Devonshire and Crown Streets

Following a number of high risk safety incidents with pedestrians, trams, buses and motor vehicles and complaints about long wait times for pedestrians, trams, buses and vehicles, TfNSW will change the traffic conditions on Marlborough, Devonshire and Crown Streets in Surry Hills.

Our work


To improve safety, walkability and service reliability, Transport for NSW is planning to carry out the following changes:

 Marlborough Street south will be closed to traffic at Devonshire Street, preventing access in all directions.


- Marlborough Street north will be restricted to a left in left out arrangement with Devonshire Street.
- The traffic lights at the Marlborough Street and Devonshire Street intersection will be removed.
- There will be no right hand turn both eastbound and westbound from Devonshire Street into Crown Street.


Our work schedule

The work involves removing traffic lights at Marlborough Street and Devonshire Street, installing new signage and closing off Marlborough Street South so there will be no road access to Devonshire Street. The work will start late **February 2021** and will take place over two night shifts.
