

Vale Road upgrade at Perthville now complete

The NSW Government provided \$3.1 million to upgrade Vale Road at Perthville, to provide a longer lasting and safer road.

Project update

Roads and Maritime Services has completed road work to upgrade the Vale Road in Perthville, which included widening and resurfacing the road.

The Vale Road, north of Perthville was narrow, rough and in need of an upgrade. The community was consulted regarding the design of the upgrade and the impacts to the avenue of elm trees.

Following community consultation the upgrade was designed to avoid significant impacts to the avenue of elm trees.

Work on the project started in March 2018 and finished in July 2018, the community is thanked for their patience during this important work.

Project benefits

The key benefits of the work include:

- A longer lasting, smoother and stronger road
- Improved safety for road users by providing wider travel lanes and sealed road shoulders
- Improved drainage and reduced maintenance costs.

Work completed

The following improvements have been completed as part of the project:

- Widened and upgraded 1.7 kilometres of road and provided an asphalt surface
- Drainage improvements including installing new kerb and guttering at selected locations
- Removed six trees to enable road widening.

Ongoing maintenance

The road surface has been replaced with asphalt which will provide a smoother, stronger and quieter road.

The road surface is expected to last for 40 years, with minor maintenance work to be carried out every ten years.
