Victoria Road – Gladesville Bridge

This information has been developed to provide more detail about the proposed changes across Victoria Road, and to provide answers to frequently asked questions from stakeholders and the community.

Why are changes needed?

Victoria Road's communities and centres have witnessed growing congestion, pollution, poor urban amenity, tired public domain and slow and unreliable public transport due to a high volume of vehicles and narrow lane widths.

Transport for NSW is taking key steps to improve bus services along Victoria Road for trips towards the city by improving public transport options, to encourage more people to use public transport.

These changes are being developed by The NSW Government's Bus Priority Infrastructure Program, which will improve the reliability and efficiency of bus services for our public transport customers.

What are the proposed changes on Victoria Road?

- Extension of citybound bus lane on Gladesville Bridge between Huntleys Point Road and Westbourne Street Drummoyne, between 6am to 7pm, Monday to Friday
- Replacing the existing citybound T3 lane with a bus lane
- Installing a painted kerbside bus lane and new bus lane signs
- Pavement resurfacing and new line markings

What are the benefits of installing bus lanes?

- Improving bus travel time
- Improving bus service reliability
- Reducing journey times for bus customers
- Improving safety for road users
- Making public transport a more attractive alternative

When will construction start and how long will it take to complete?

Construction will commence on 10 October 2022 and is likely to be finished by 5 December 2022, depending on weather conditions.



Will the construction work impact traffic?

Most of the construction work will take place at night to avoid general daytime and weekday traffic.

Will any lanes be closed?

One to two lanes will be closed during the night only, to minimise traffic congestion.

What does it mean for general traffic?

Once the work is complete general traffic will not be permitted to use the bus lane between 6am to 7pm Monday to Friday, except for taxis, hire cars, emergency vehicles, motorcycles and buses. Vehicles are permitted to enter a bus lane if they are within 100 metres of undertaking a turn.

Will any parking be removed?

No existing parking will be removed by this work.

Will any trees be removed?

There is currently no intention to remove any trees during the process of the work.
