Start of work on Waterfall Way, 60 kilometres east of Armidale, from 05 October

The Australian and NSW governments are providing funding through the Australian Government's Road Safety program and the NSW Government's \$50 million Waterfall Way improvement program to carry out essential improvement work, 60 kilometres east of Armidale, to provide a safer, longer lasting road.

Armidale Council will carry out the work on behalf of Transport for NSW which involves repairing the pavement, widening the shoulders, upgrading drainage and installing guard rail as part of the Safer Roads program.

Work hours

Work will be carried out from **Wednesday 5 October for about 12 months**, weather permitting. We will be working from **Monday to Friday** between **7am** and **6pm**, and on **Saturday** between **8am** and **1pm**, when required.

How will the work affect you?

Work will involve the use of machinery, which generate noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise by turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use, positioning machinery away from residences and where possible starting noisy activities later in the morning.

Access to properties will be maintained. If this should change, affected residents will be notified.

Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes to ensure the safety of road users and workers.

Traffic control and a reduced 40km/h speed limit will be in place for the duration of the work.

Single lane alternate traffic flow arrangements will be in place during work hours, with occasional implementation at night as required. Motorists should allow up to five minutes extra travel time while this traffic control is in place.
