Work on Gipps Street, Claremont Meadows from Monday 10 August

The Australian and NSW governments are funding this work as part of the \$70 million upgrade of Gipps Street and Kent Road (the Werrington Arterial Road). This project is part of the Western Sydney Infrastructure Plan and will include building new southbound lanes and a noise wall and relocating electricity cables.

New southbound lanes

Roads and Maritime will start work to build two new southbound lanes between the Great Western Highway and Caddens Road. This work will take place adjacent to Gipps Street and includes earthwork, installing concrete safety barriers, new road drainage, building the new road and upgrading the Caddens and Fowler Street intersections.

The work will be carried out from **Monday 10 August 2015** to **Friday 28 February 2016**, excluding Sundays and public holidays, weather permitting. Our working hours will be from **7am to 6pm**, Monday to Friday and **8am to 1pm** on Saturdays. Some night work may be needed in the future and we will notify the community before this begins.

Electrical cables over the M4 Motorway

Night work will be carried out to replace existing high voltage electrical cables over the M4 Motorway. This requires machinery to be set up on both sides of the M4 on the shoulder of Kent Road.

The work will be completed on **Saturday 15 August**, weather permitting. Our working hours will be from **7pm to 6am**. In the event that this work is rescheduled, it will be carried out on **Saturday 29 August** between **7pm** and **6am**, weather permitting.

Noise wall construction work

A noise wall will be built on the western side of Gipps Street between the Great Western Highway and Caddens Road. The noise wall will be about 3.5 metres high and extend around 1.3km. It will be built within the road reserve behind private property boundary fences. Work will include surveying, concreting, drilling foundations, installing panels and removing vegetation.

The work will be carried out from **Monday 17 August** to **Friday 29 January 2016**, weather permitting. Our working hours will be from **7am to 6pm**, **Monday to Friday** and **8am to 1pm** on **Saturdays**.

How will the work affect you?

There will be some noise associated with this work however we will make every effort to minimise and complete the work as quickly as possible. The map helps to better explain the project.

Traffic changes

Lane closures will be in place overnight on the M4 Motorway on **Saturday 15 August** to assist with the electrical cabling work and this may affect travel times by up to 10 minutes.

One lane in each direction will be closed from 11pm while lane two in each direction will be closed from 2am to 4am. Between 2am and 3.30am traffic controllers will stop and slow traffic in the remaining lane in each direction. All lanes will re-open by 5am.

While the southbound lanes are being built there may also be occasional short delays to traffic along Kent Road and Gipps Street, as traffic controllers help trucks to safely enter and exit our construction sites.

Access to properties and the SES facility will be maintained throughout the work. One lane will remain closed and traffic control will be in place on Kent Road where it crosses the M4 Motorway.

Caddens Road (south) will remain closed at Gipps Street and Blackwood Street until **Friday 16 October**. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs. For the latest traffic updates, call 132 701, visit livetraffic.com or download the Live Traffic NSW App.
