



Emergency maintenance work on Bells Line of Road at Mount Tomah from Wednesday 8 December 2021

The NSW Government is carrying out essential work as part of ongoing maintenance to the road network.

Transport for NSW will be carrying out the work which includes slope repairs and road resurfacing work on Bells Line of Road, Mt Tomah. This work is not related to the existing slope remediation 300m in the eastbound direction, following the March 2021 wet weather event

This work is intended as a temporary repair to open the road before the Christmas holiday period. We will continue to monitor the area to inform future slope remediation work.

In recent weeks we have been carrying out geotechnical assessments, installing monitoring devices and conducting repairs to the road. Transport for NSW will continue to monitor slope movement closely.

How will the work affect you?

We will be working between 7am and 5pm from Monday to Sunday and are aiming to complete the work by Sunday 19 December 2021, weather permitting.

There will be up to 12 day shifts between Wednesday 8 December and Monday 20 December, however this may change due to wet weather and environmental conditions. By working 12 days straight, we reduce the overall length of our work and limit the impact to the local community.

Traffic changes

A reduced speed limit of 40 km/h and traffic controls will be in place during work hours for the safety of road users and workers.

Motorists are advised to drive to the conditions, allow extra travel time and follow the direction of signs and traffic control.


