Investigation and night work on the Westlink M7

Transport for NSW is proposing to support the future Western Sydney Aerotropolis and the surrounding growth areas to increase capacity and widen the Westlink M7.

The Westlink M7 is a key transport route for Greater Sydney, and it regularly experiences congestion.

Transport proposes to widen the Westlink M7 within the existing median by adding one lane in each direction. The widening would occur between the M5 interchange at Prestons, approximately 140 metres south of the Kurrajong Road overhead bridge and the Westlink M7 bridge at Richmond Road in Oakhurst/Glendenning.

Once complete, there would be three lanes of traffic in each direction. The widening would not occur through the Light Horse Interchange at the M4 Motorway.

The proposal is currently being assessed by the Department of Planning and Environment with announcement expected in early 2023.

Investigation work

Transport will be carrying out utility and ground surface investigations at some sections along the Westlink M7, which includes the shared path and at roads under the Westlink M7 bridges. This work will help to inform the ongoing development and design of the proposal.

Our work schedule

We will be on site for three day shifts and 12 night shifts between Sunday 8 January and Tuesday 24 January, weather permitting.

Our day work hours will be from **7am** to **6pm Monday** to **Friday** and **8am** to **1pm** on **Saturday**. Our night work hours will be from **9pm** to **5am, Monday** to **Sunday**. We will not work on public holidays.

We will work no more than two nights in each location.

How will the work affect you

Some of our work needs to be carried out at night to minimise traffic disruption and reduce safety risks to our workers and road users. The investigation work may be noisy at times, but we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including completing noisier activities by midnight.

Some of our work will be carried out on sections of the Westlink M7 shared path, single lane access for cyclists and pedestrians will be maintained while we work. Please keep to shared path speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.
