

Safety improvements on Wilfred Barrett Drive, Magenta and The Entrance North from Sunday 30 May

This NSW Government is investing \$22.5 million in this project between Wyuna Avenue and north of Pelican Beach Road to improve safety and reduce crashes.

Transport for NSW will carry out the work along a four kilometre section of the road. We have included an image to show the location of the work. Work will involve:

- widening the road to provide a one metre wide central median and three metre southbound shoulders
- providing right turn bays into Pelican Beach Road and the car park for Red Gum Trail walking track
- installing safety barriers
- installing audio-tactile line marking (rumble strips) which provides a noise and vibratory warning to a driver or rider who has drifted from their lane

Work will start from the northern end of the project near Pelican Beach Road and will move gradually south towards The Entrance North over the next 12 months.

Most work will be carried out between **7pm** and **5am** from **Sunday** to **Thursday** nights. Some work activities at the start of the project will be carried out between **7am** and **5pm** from **Monday** to **Friday**. We expect to complete the work in **12 months**, weather permitting.

How will the work affect you?

The work will involve the use of machinery which generates some noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise by turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use and completing noisier activities earlier in the night.

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe. A reduced speed limit will be in place during the work. Lane and shoulder closures will be in place during night work and stop/slow traffic arrangements will be in place during day work and may affect travel times.

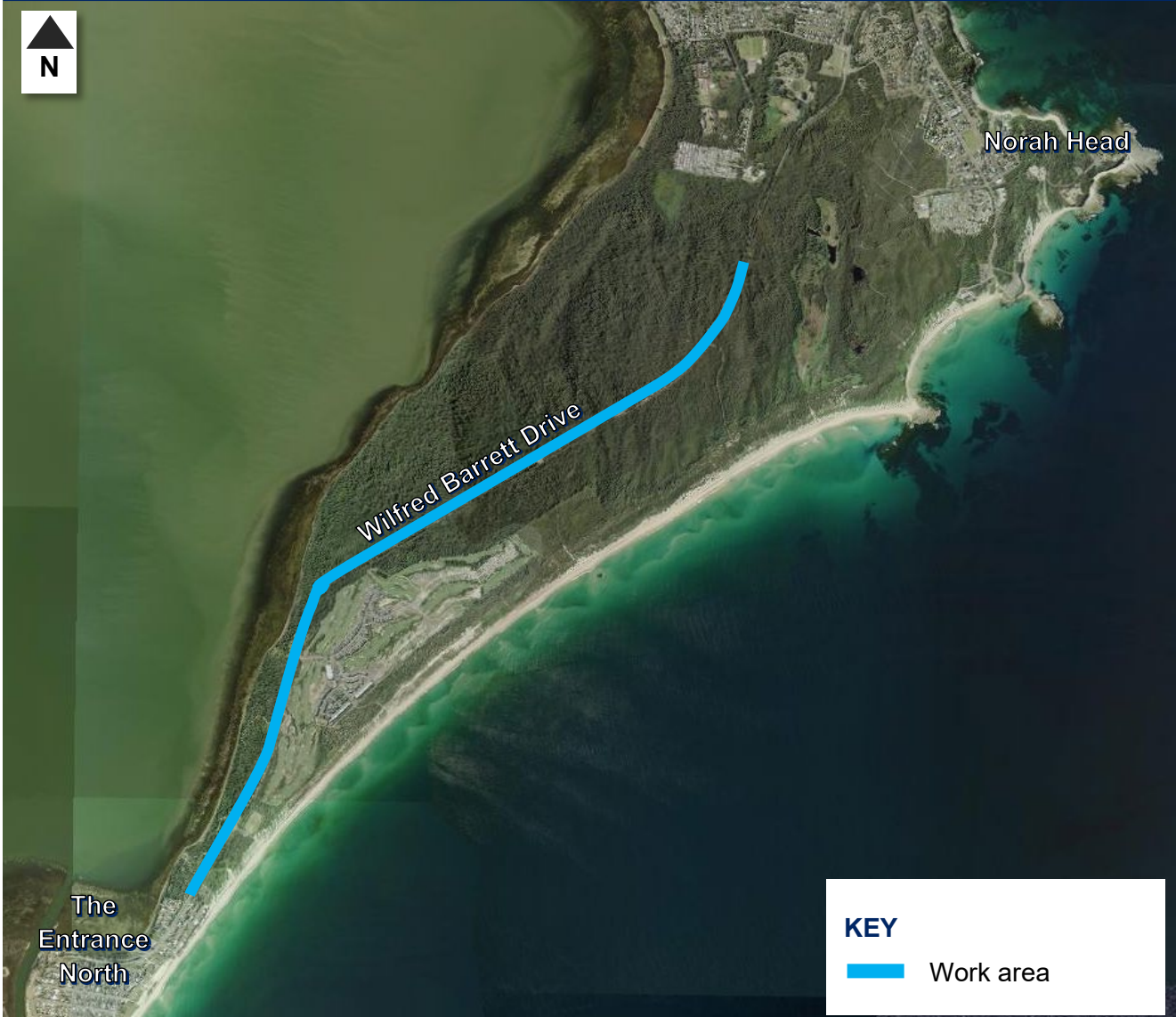
