

# Windsor Bridge replacement project

## Construction update – Looking forward to project completion

The new Windsor Bridge and upgraded intersections are now providing a safe and reliable crossing over the Hawkesbury River at Windsor.

Work will continue over the next few months to complete the project and open the upgraded Thompson Square to the community. The following work will take place.

### Flood repair work

We will be removing remaining debris from underneath the bridge that has been trapped and will repair the paint damage to the piers.

This will also include the cleaning of the basins and drainage systems along the bridge.

### Landscaping

Landscaping will continue and be completed on:

- northern side of the river
- Terrace on the south side of the river
- along Wilberforce Road and Macquarie Park Access Road
- Thompson Square.

Shared paths around Macquarie Park will be completed and opened to the public.

## Roadwork

We will commence construction of the new road surface pavement on The Terrace on the south side of the river. This involves asphaltting and installing a decorative concrete pavement.

## Structures

With concrete structures now completed for the southern viewing platform, we will now work to complete the interpretation signage and landscaping around the viewing platform.

## Utility relocations

### Electrical

Construction of the street lighting in Thompson Square will be undertaken during this month and will be commissioned in May.

## Our work schedule

To support industry and continue delivering critical infrastructure, the NSW Government introduced new rules last year allowing construction sites, including public infrastructure projects, to operate on weekends and public holidays.

The work schedule order has now been extended to 31 March 2022. We have been using these new rules for some time and starting from the **10 April**, we will be working most **Saturdays, from 7am until 6pm**.

## How the work will affect you

There may be some noise and disruption associated with this work, including vehicle movements. We are making every effort to minimise noise and disruption to the community during construction.

## Traffic changes

Infrequent traffic changes may occur from time to time to enable final work inspections, installed services and to address minor repairs if required.
