

Windsor Bridge replacement project – southern viewing platform maintenance work from Tuesday 5 October

Transport for NSW will carry out concrete maintenance work, which includes installing scaffolding and drapes to the underside of the platform, drilling and concrete repairs. We have included a map to show the location of the project overleaf.

We will be working between **7am** and **6pm** from **Monday to Friday** and **8am to 1pm Saturdays** and expect to complete the work in **14 weeks**, weather permitting. We will let you know in advance if we need to do any work outside these times.

No work will take place over the Christmas period between the 24 December 2021 and 3 January 2022.

How will the work affect you?

Some work will involve the use of machinery which generates some noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise impacts.

While the work is being carried out, site amenities for the workers will be located in the Upper Wharf carpark. Around six car spaces will be used. Once the work is complete, the area will be restored.

For some periods of this work, the southern viewing platform will be closed to the public to allow work activities to be conducted safely.

Traffic changes

During the work, there will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe. Traffic controllers will be used to ensure the safety of motorists, pedestrians and workers. Generally, this would be required when machinery or equipment is to be delivered or removed from the work location.
