

New clearways on Windsor Road

Between Showground Road, Castle Hill and Seven Hills Road, Baulkham Hills

Project Update | September 2018

The NSW Government is funding this project as part of its clearways program which aims to reduce congestion and delays on Sydney's roads.

From **Monday 10 September 2018** new clearways will be operational on Windsor Road between Showground Road, Castle Hill and Seven Hills Road, Baulkham Hills. The existing parking restrictions and new clearway hours are shown below and on the map.

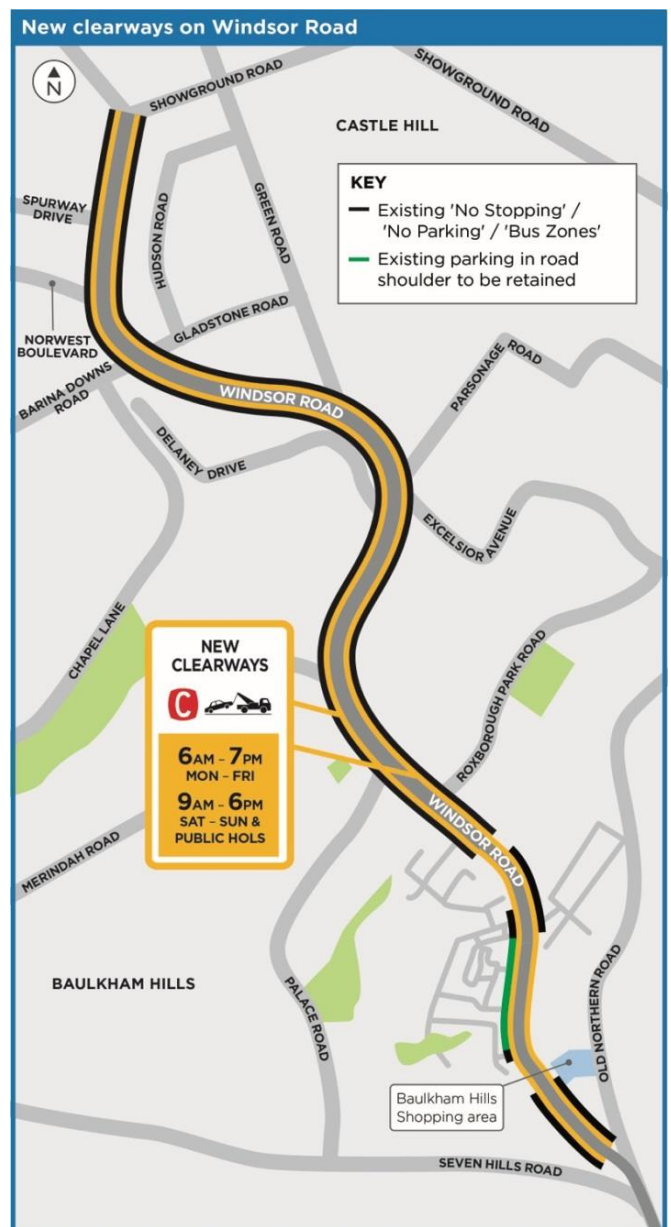
The clearways will operate in both directions from:

- 6am to 7pm on weekdays
- 9am to 6pm on weekends and public holidays

Existing parking restrictions will continue to apply outside of the clearway hours. However, parking will continue to be permitted in the road shoulder located next to the travel lane on Windsor Road between Rembrandt Drive and Coronation Road. This area is marked in green on the map.

Clearways help **improve journey times** by making an additional lane available to traffic during clearway hours, allowing drivers to get to their destination sooner. They have an immediate **positive impact on traffic flow** as existing road space is used for the movement of vehicles. Maximising road space for traffic movement **improves the efficiency of intersections** along the corridor as all lanes are used.

The new weekday and weekend clearways will improve the journey times for the 43,000 motorists travelling on this corridor each day which means less time in traffic and more time doing the things you enjoy.



What happens next?

The new clearway signs and posts will be installed between **Sunday 26 August and Sunday 9 September**, weather permitting. Our working hours will be between 8pm and 5am from Monday to Sunday.

How will the work affect me?

There will be some noise associated with this work but we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including completing the noisier tasks by **11pm**.

During the installation work, there will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe. Lane closures will be in place and may affect travel times. Please keep to speed limits and follow signs and traffic controllers' directions. For the latest traffic updates, you can call 132 701, visit livetraffic.com or download the Live Traffic NSW App.

As a resident or visitor, what does this mean for me?

The new clearways will change the ability to park or pick up and drop off family, friends and deliveries in front of properties along Windsor Road. If you currently live or visit this section of Windsor Road, you will need to reconsider where to park during the clearway hours.

If you do not have a driveway, garage or carport on your property, local streets are available for you to park during the clearway hours subject to any council restrictions. Outside the clearway hours, existing parking restrictions will remain in place.

As clearways continue to be rolled out across Sydney, you, your family and friends will experience more efficient, safer, and more reliable journey times. This means less time in the car, and more time doing the things you enjoy.



Background

The NSW Government announced the Sydney Clearways Strategy as one of its key initiatives to reduce congestion on Sydney's major roads. \$121 million was committed to implementing the strategy and installing new clearways on Sydney's road network.

Installing new and extended clearways on weekdays and weekends can help reduce congestion in many areas of Sydney by allowing motorists to use all traffic lanes.

Since 2013, we have installed over 450 kilometres of new and extended clearways across some of Sydney's busiest road corridors. We are continuing to investigate where new and extended clearways would help ease congestion and establish more reliable travel times for motorists across the network.


