

## New construction schedule at Woodville Road and Parramatta Road, Granville and Holroyd from Friday 3 June 2022

May 2022

The NSW Government is widening and upgrading the intersection of Woodville Road and Parramatta Road, in Granville and Holroyd, to ease congestion, reduce travel times and improve safety on this section of Parramatta Road.

Work is continuing on Woodville Road, Parramatta Road and the M4 Westbound Motorway at Woodville Road.

Between June and July 2022, our work will include:

- completion of remaining pavement construction and asphaltting work at Woodville Road, Parramatta Road and the M4 Westbound Motorway
- reinstatement of road crossings and footpaths, and asphalt works at the Church Street Eastbound Exit Ramp intersection
- completion of line marking and signage
- Traffic Control Signal upgrades and median construction
- extension of concrete barriers along M4 Westbound Motorway
- continuing Intelligent Transport Systems (ITS) work
- new landscaping and footpath
- site demobilisation.

Work is expected to be completed in the next few months. We will update the community again as we near completion.

### Changes to our construction schedule

Higher than average rainfall experienced across Sydney, since early 2022, has impacted construction activities and project progression. With further wet weather forecasted over the coming months we have been looking at ways to limit our impact on the community and complete this important upgrade as quickly as possible.

From **Friday 3 June 2022** we will be changing our construction schedule.

## Our new work schedule from Friday 3 June 2022

Our work schedule will continue to be in place between **Wednesday 1 June** and **Sunday 31 July 2022**.

We will continue to work up to **five night shifts** per week. Our night hours will be between **8pm** until **5am** the next day, **Sunday** to **Thursday**. We will not work more than five continuous nights in a scheduled work week however from **Friday 3 June 2022** we may work on **Friday** and **Saturday** nights, if weather and site conditions, or staff availability does not allow us to work fully between Sunday and Thursday.

We will work up to **six day shifts** per week. Our day hours will be between **7am** to **6pm**, **Monday** to **Friday**, and **8am** to **1pm** on **Saturdays**.

We will not work on Sundays (before 8pm) or during public holidays. During the June long weekend, we will not work between **6pm Friday 10 June** and **7am Tuesday 14 June 2022**.

### How will the work affect you?

Some work activities may be noisy. We will do everything we can to minimise noise impacts, including using quieter equipment where we can, turning off equipment and vehicles when they are not in use and completing noisier tasks by midnight.

### Traffic changes

Minor traffic disruptions will have traffic control measures in place. Access to driveways and buildings will be maintained at all times.

Due to works required to be carried out at night, we will utilise traffic control setups that will affect traffic flow around the Woodville Road and Parramatta Road intersection.
