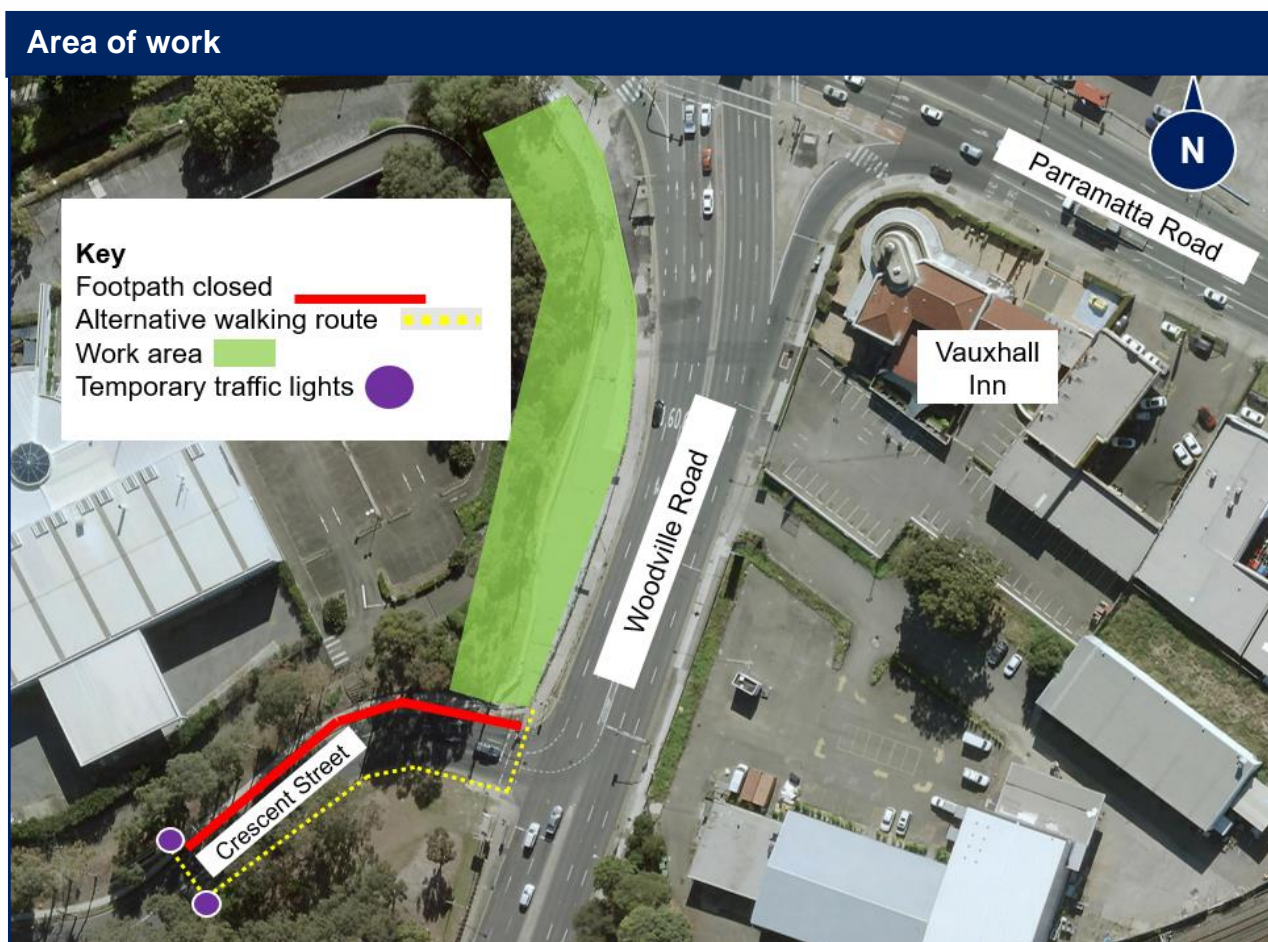


## Temporary footpath closure on Crescent Street, Holroyd starting on 24 November 2021

The NSW Government is widening and upgrading the intersection of Woodville Road and Parramatta Road in Granville and Holroyd. These improvements will help ease congestion, reduce travel times and improve safety on this section of Parramatta Road.

### Why are we closing the footpath?

As part of the upgrade, we will install a new watermain within the kerbside lane along Crescent Street, near Woodville Road at Holroyd. To do this, we need to temporarily close the footpath at the northern corner of Crescent Street from **24 November 2021 to February 2022**, weather permitting. Signage and traffic signals will ensure pedestrians are redirected safely to the other side of Crescent Street via the temporary path. (see map below).



Work will include:

- Watermain investigation in road verge
- Preparation for the new traffic signals
- Demolition of the existing road and footpath
- Reinstatement of the road and footpath

Equipment used for this work includes but is not limited to:

- Vacuum excavation truck
- Road-saw
- Excavator(s)
- Body Truck(s)
- Concrete Truck(s)
- Roller(s)
- Water truck(s)

## How will the work affect you?

There will be temporary traffic changes during our work hours to ensure the work zone is safe. This may affect travel times. Please keep to speed limits and follow signs and traffic controllers' directions.

- Pedestrians will be detoured via the opposite side of Crescent Street
- Work will generate some noise and our team will minimise impacts where possible, including completing noisier activities by midnight
- Access to driveways and buildings will be maintained at all times
- An increase of light vehicles near the work sites
- Minor traffic disruptions with traffic control measures in place

## Our work schedule

This temporary traffic change will be in place from **24 November 2021 until 28 February 2022**. The footpath will be re-opened as soon as the work is complete. Our night work hours will be Sunday to Thursday nights from **8pm to 5am**. Our day work hours are **7am to 6pm**, Monday to Friday and **8am until 1pm** on Saturdays. We may require some scheduling flexibility or additional days' work depending on weather conditions and Public Health Orders.

There will be **no work completed** on public holidays.
