

## Changed traffic conditions at the M4 Motorway on and off ramps at Woodville Road, Holroyd

March 2022

The NSW Government is widening and upgrading the intersection of Woodville Road and Parramatta Road in Granville and Holroyd, to ease congestion, reduce travel times and improve safety on this section of Parramatta Road.

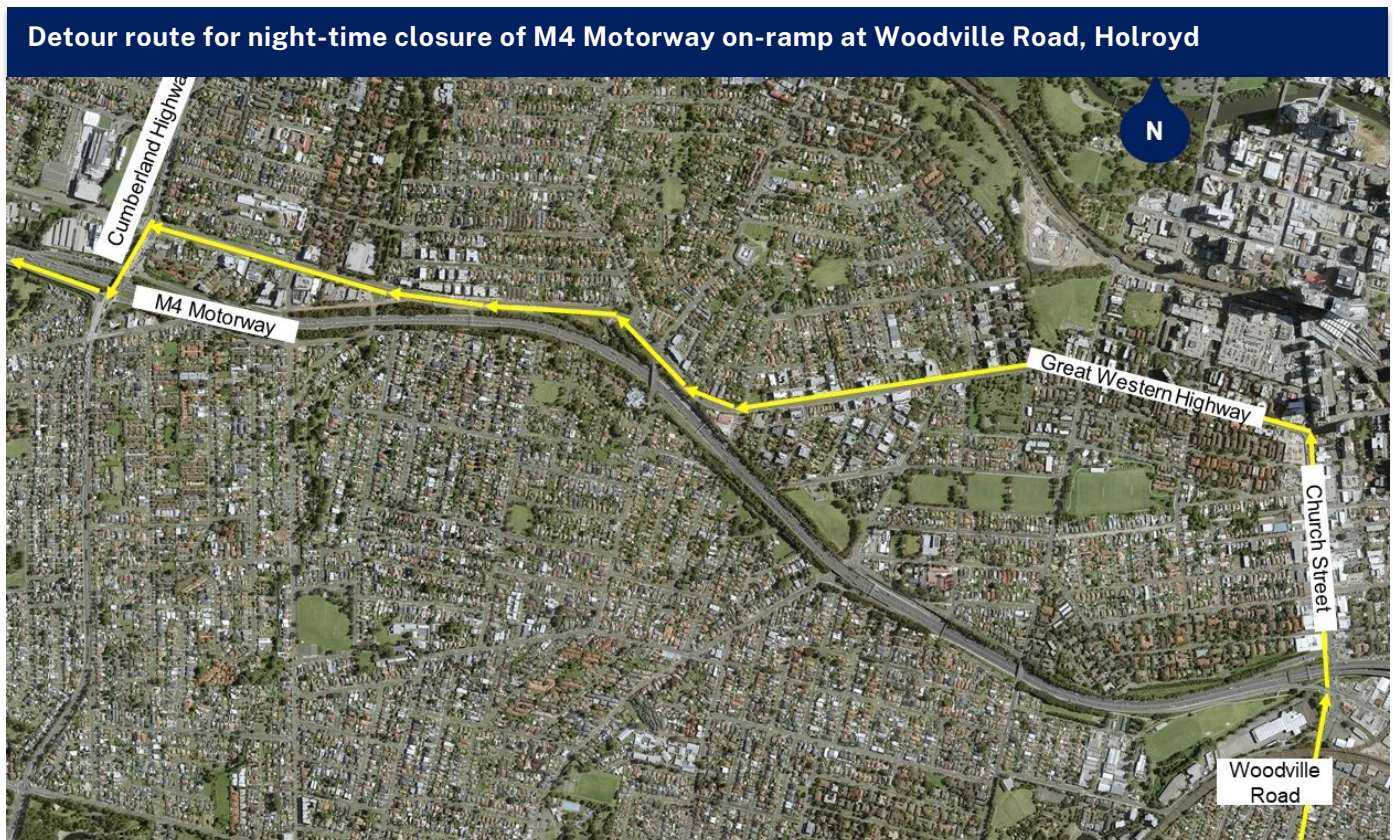
Work is continuing on Woodville and Parramatta Roads. Upcoming work will include carrying out essential work on the M4 Motorway on and off ramps at Woodville Road between **Thursday 7 April and Tuesday 31 May 2022**. Night ramp closures will be in place to ensure that we can safely carry out this work.

### Night ramp closures

- The M4 motorway on-ramp at Woodville Road will be closed for **up to 20 night shifts**. A detour route will be in place.
- The M4 motorway off-ramp at Woodville Road will remain open during works, with lane closures in place for **up to 10 night shifts**. Traffic controls will be in place.

## Our work schedule

We will be on site for up to **30 night shifts** between **Thursday 7 April and Tuesday 31 May 2022**, site conditions and weather permitting. Our work hours will be between **8pm until 5am** the next day, **Sunday to Thursday**. We will not work on Saturdays or on public holidays. We cannot work during periods of heavy rainfall.

## Construction during Easter and Anzac Day

**Easter:** the construction site will close over the Easter holiday period from **6pm on Thursday 14 April** until **7am on Tuesday 19 April 2022**.

**Anzac Day:** the construction site will be closed from **5pm on Friday 22 April** and until **7am on Tuesday 26 April 2022**.

## How will the work affect you?

Our work needs to be carried out at night to limit disruption to traffic and reduce safety risks to our workers and motorists. Some work activities may generate high noise levels. We will do everything we can to minimise noise impacts, including using quieter equipment where we can, turning off equipment and vehicles when they are not in use and completing the noisier tasks by midnight.

Minor traffic disruptions will have traffic control measures in place, and access to driveways and buildings will be maintained at all times.

## Traffic changes

Motorists using the M4 motorway on-ramp at Woodville Road will be detoured **via Church Street and the Great Western Highway to access to the M4 westbound at Cumberland Highway interchange**.

For motorists using the M4 Motorway off-ramp at Woodville Road, there will be lane closures and traffic controls in place to ensure the work zone is safe for our workers and motorists.
