

Investigation work at Woodville Road, Parramatta Road and Church Street, Granville

Work scheduled for February 2020

Transport for NSW | January 2020

In February 2020, Transport for NSW will undertake investigation work around the intersection of Woodville Road, Parramatta Road and Church Street, Granville, south of the M4 Western Motorway.

The work, which is scheduled to begin on **Monday 10 February 2020**, will survey gas, water, electrical and telecommunications infrastructure. The work involves drilling and concrete cutting, as well as reinstating the road pavement when complete.

The survey is funded under the \$30 million Parramatta Congestion Improvement Program and will help Transport for NSW assess potential improvements to the intersection.

In December 2019, Transport for NSW announced the completion of a new right-turn lane and extended left-turn lane on the M4 Western Motorway's Church Street exit ramp.

Work schedule

The work will be carried over six night shifts between **Monday 10 February** and **Friday 21 February 2020**, weather permitting. Our night work hours are **Sunday to Thursday, between 6pm to 7am**. We won't work on public holidays.

How will the work affect you?

Our work may be noisy at times, but we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including completing the noisier activities (such as drilling and concrete cutting) by midnight.

Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes, including reduced speed limits and lane closures, while the work is carried out.
