Church Street corridor intersection upgrades, Parramatta and Holroyd

February 2021

Transport for NSW is upgrading two vital intersections on the southern side of Parramatta's CBD.

The intersection of **Great Western Highway, Church Street and Parkes Street** has been under construction since March 2020, while the main body of work at the intersection of **Woodville Road, Church Street and Parramatta Road** began in late-2020.

Update: Great Western Highway, Church Street and Parkes Street

Since work began, we've completed a massive task to relocate underground utilities, including gas, water and electrical infrastructure, as well as about 70 kilometres of telecommunications cabling that runs through this busy intersection.

We've also completed conduits for the new traffic signals infrastructure. Over the coming months, we'll continue to build new stormwater infrastructure along the western side of Church Street, between Lansdowne Street and Great Western Highway. We'll also start resurfacing the newly widened Great Western Highway approach to the intersection.

We've faced a number of unforeseen challenges over the past 12 months, which have caused some delays to our work.

We continue to safely and quickly remove underground asbestos as it's located along the line of our work. We've also appropriately managed the discovery of potentially heritage-significant materials along the line of construction. We've worked with heritage experts to ensure this material is handled sensitively.

Over the coming months, we'll continue to build new stormwater infrastructure along the western side of Church Street, between Lansdowne Street and Great Western Highway. We'll also start continue pavement work as we complete sections of the new roadway.

Work schedule: Great Western Highway, Church Street and Parkes Street

We will be at work up to **67 day shifts** and **53 night shifts** over the coming months. Our day work hours are **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday**, and from **8am to 1pm, Saturdays**. Our night work hours are from **8pm to 5am, Sunday to Thursday**. We won't work during the day on Sundays or on public holidays.

Our work might be noisy at times, but we will continue to complete the noisiest tasks, such as jackhammering and concrete cutting, before midnight.

Update: Woodville Road, Church Street and Parramatta Road

Work at the intersection of Woodville Road, Church Street and Parramatta began in late-2020 and has involved establishing the site, constructing retaining walls and relocating underground utilities.

Workers have also spent considerable time safely removing and disposing of asbestos containing materials, which were uncovered at the site during early excavation work. Asbestos finds are common during road work and, if handled appropriately, do not pose a health risk to the public.

Over the coming months, work will focus on relocating underground and aboveground utilities, including telecommunications and street lighting infrastructure. We'll also be constructing extensive new stormwater infrastructure across Parramatta Road.

Work to upgrade the intersection Road is funded by the NSW and Australian governments as part of the plan to stimulate the economy as it recovers from the COVID-19 pandemic.

Work schedule: Woodville Road, Church Street and Parramatta Road

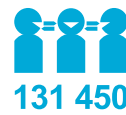
