

Extended construction schedule at Woodville Road and Parramatta Road, Granville and Holroyd from Friday 22 July 2022

July 2022

The NSW Government is widening and upgrading the intersection of Woodville Road and Parramatta Road, in Granville and Holroyd, to ease congestion, reduce travel times and improve safety on this section of Parramatta Road.

Work is continuing on Woodville Road, Parramatta Road and the M4 Westbound Motorway at Woodville Road. We expect to complete the work in the coming weeks, weather permitting.

Work still to be completed includes:

- completion of remaining pavement construction and asphaltting work at Woodville Road, Parramatta Road and the M4 Westbound Motorway
- reinstatement of road crossings and footpaths, and asphalt works at the Church Street Eastbound Motorway exit ramp intersection
- Church Street M4 Westbound Motorway entry ramp metering commissioning
- completion of line marking and signage
- Traffic Control Signal upgrades and median construction
- extension of concrete barriers along M4 Westbound Motorway
- continuing Intelligent Transport Systems (ITS) work
- new landscaping and footpath work
- site demobilisation.

Changes to our construction schedule

Ongoing wet weather conditions continue to impact construction activities and project progression. In order to limit our impact on the community, and complete this important upgrade as quickly as possible, we will be extending the number of nights we work per week for a short period of time.

From **Friday 22 July 2022** we will be working **up to seven nights per week**. The new construction schedule will remain in place until **Sunday 14 August 2022**.

From Monday 15 August 2022 we will return to our previous work schedule. Please see overleaf for more information on our work schedule.

Our work schedule

Between **Friday 22 July** and **Sunday 14 August 2022**, we will work up to **seven night shifts** per week. Our night hours will be between **8pm until 5am**, the next day.

We will continue to work up to **six day shifts** per week. Our day hours will be between **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday**, and **8am to 1pm on Saturdays**.

Between **Monday 15 August** and **Wednesday 31 August 2022**, we will return to **five night shifts** per week. Our night hours will be between **8pm until 5am** the next day, **Sunday to Thursday**. We will not work more than five continuous nights in a scheduled work week however we may work on Friday and Saturday nights, if weather and site conditions, or staff availability does not allow us to work fully between Sunday and Thursday.

We will continue to work up to **six day shifts** per week. Our day hours will be between **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday**, and **8am to 1pm on Saturdays**.

How will the work affect you?

Some work activities may be noisy. We will do everything we can to minimise noise impacts, including using quieter equipment where we can, turning off equipment and vehicles when they are not in use and completing noisier tasks by midnight.

Traffic changes

Minor traffic disruptions will have traffic control measures in place. Access to driveways and buildings will be maintained at all times.

Due to works required to be carried out at night, we will utilise traffic control setups that will affect traffic flow around the Woodville Road and Parramatta Road intersection. Traffic changes may affect travel times.
