### Woolwich Wharf to reopen on Wednesday 30 September.

The wharf has been upgraded as part of the NSW Government's Transport Access Program – an initiative to deliver accessible, modern, safe transport. The improvements to Woolwich Wharf include increased safety, accessibility and comfort for customers.

F8 Cockatoo Island ferry services will resume from 6.24am on Wednesday 30 September from Woolwich Wharf. Ferry services will no longer operate to the temporary wharf at Clarke Road. The temporary bus service, route 537, providing connections to Clarke Road Wharf during construction will also stop operating.
