

# Bridge closure and repair work on Brig O'Johnston Bridge, Clarence Town from Tuesday 15 April

Transport for NSW acknowledges the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

The NSW Government is investing in rehabilitation work on Brig O'Johnston Bridge at Clarence Town.

#### What work are we doing?

Transport for NSW is carrying out emergency maintenance work as a precautionary measure, after identifying a defect following a routine inspection.

## When and where we'll be working

Repair work will be carried out between **8am** and **4pm** on **Tuesday 15 April** and **Wednesday 16 April**, weather permitting. This work will require a full bridge closure and detour arrangements will be in place.

Transport will be back on site in the coming months to carry out more significant repair and rehabilitation work to improve the safety of the bridge. We will provide an update soon about when we will be on site and associated traffic management plans.

### What will this mean for you?

The work will involve the use of machinery which generates some noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise by turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

You may notice:

- Workers and vehicles
- Traffic controllers and signage

- Road closures and reduced speed limits
- Noise from machinery and equipment.

#### Traffic impacts

A detour for light vehicles is available to the south via Duke Street, Clarence Town and East Seaham roads, which is expected to add up to 30 minutes additional travel time. See detour map overleaf.

A detour for heavy vehicles is available via Clarence Town, East Seaham and Italia roads, the Pacific Highway and The Bucketts Way, which is expected to add up to 50 minutes travel time. See detour overleaf. Please note, Glen Martin Road is not suitable for heavy vehicle use due to a culvert failure.


Heavy and light vehicle drivers should plan their journey and allow extra travel time, drive to the conditions and follow the directions of signs and traffic control.

Pedestrians are advised that bridge access will be unavailable while repairs are completed, between 8am and 4pm each day.


