

DETERMINATION

Section 32C, Passenger Transport Act 1990

I, Leslie Robert Wielinga, Director-General, Transport NSW hereby make the following determination for the purposes of s. 32C(1) of the *Passenger Transport Act 1990*:-

- (1) Two hundred and twenty-seven (227) annual licences are to be issued for taxi-cabs during the year commencing 1 July 2011 (s. 32C(1)).

NOTE: 30 of these licences will replace existing licences due to expire between 1 July 2011 and 30 June 2012.

This determination also provides for the following matters for the purposes of s. 32C(2) of the *Passenger Transport Act 1990*:-

- (2) Of the number of annual licences referred to in (1), one hundred and thirty-eight (138) annual licences are to be issued to authorised taxi-cab drivers who are also accredited taxi-cab operators or who have applied for such accreditation (s. 32C(2)(a)).
- (3) Of the annual licences referred to in (2), sixty-nine (69) are to be of unrestricted class and sixty-nine (69) are to be of peak availability class (s. 32C(2)(a)).
- (4) Of the annual licences referred to in (2), the number of annual licences that may be granted to the same applicant is limited to one (1) (s.32C(2)(b)).

This determination does not apply to licences for wheelchair accessible taxi-cabs (s. 32C(7)).

Defined terms

In this Determination:

"applicant" means a person who applies to the Director-General for a licence under Div. 4 of Pt. 4 of the *Passenger Transport Act 1990*.

"peak availability class" means a licence that may operate wholly within the Metropolitan Transport District only at times specified in the licence conditions.

"unrestricted class" means a licence that may operate wholly within the Metropolitan Transport District only and has no other operating restrictions.

All other terms in this Determination have the meaning provided for in the *Passenger Transport Act 1990*.
