

2013/14 SYDNEY ANNUAL TAXI LICENCE DETERMINATION

Section 32C, Passenger Transport Act 1990

I, Leslie Robert Wielinga, Director-General, on behalf of Transport for NSW hereby determine under section 32C(1) of the *Passenger Transport Act 1990* as follows

The number of annual licences to be issued for taxi-cabs during the year commencing on 1 July 2013 is three hundred and forty six (346).

The 346 annual licences are to comprise the following:

- A. One (1) licence of fringe area class to replace an existing annual licence of this class for Windsor/Richmond that was returned to Roads and Maritime Services between 1 January 2012 and 31 December 2012.
- B. Two hundred and eighty (280) licences of peak availability class, thirty (30) of which replace existing annual peak availability licences which were returned to Roads and Maritime Services between 1 January 2012 and 31 December 2012.
- C. Sixty five (65) licences of unrestricted class to replace existing annual licences which were returned to Roads and Maritime Services between 1 January 2012 and 31 December 2012.

This determination does not apply to licences for wheelchair accessible taxi-cabs (section 32C(7)).

Defined terms

In this Determination:

fringe area class means a licence that may operate wholly within a defined geographic area as specified in the licence details and in accordance with the licence conditions.

Metropolitan transport district has the same meaning as in the *Transport Administration Act 1988*

peak availability class means a licence that may operate wholly within the Metropolitan transport district only at times specified in the licence conditions.

unrestricted class means a licence that may operate wholly within the Metropolitan transport district only and has no other operating restrictions.

All other terms in this Determination have the meaning provided for in the *Passenger Transport Act 1990*.
