2014/15 SYDNEY ANNUAL TAXI LICENCE DETERMINATION

Section 32C, Passenger Transport Act 1990

I, David Stewart, Secretary of the Department of Transport, on behalf of Transport for NSW hereby determine under section 32C(1) of the *Passenger Transport Act 1990* as follows

The number of annual licences to be issued for taxi-cabs during the year commencing on 1 July 2014 is three hundred and twelve (312).

The 312 annual licences are to comprise the following:

- A. One hundred and ninety five (195) licences of peak availability class, one hundred (100) of which replace existing annual peak availability licences which were or are expected to be returned to Roads and Maritime Services during calendar years 2013 and 2014.
- B. One hundred and seventeen (117) licences of unrestricted class, all of which replace existing annual licences which were which were or are expected to be returned to Roads and Maritime Services during calendar years 2013 and 2014.

This determination does not apply to licences for wheelchair accessible taxi-cabs (section 32C(7)).

Defined terms

In this Determination:

Metropolitan transport district has the same meaning as in the *Transport Administration Act* 1988

peak availability class means a licence that may operate wholly within the Metropolitan transport district only at times specified in the licence conditions.

unrestricted class means a licence that may operate wholly within the Metropolitan transport district only and has no other operating restrictions.

All other terms in this Determination have the meaning provided for in the *Passenger Transport Act 1990.*
