



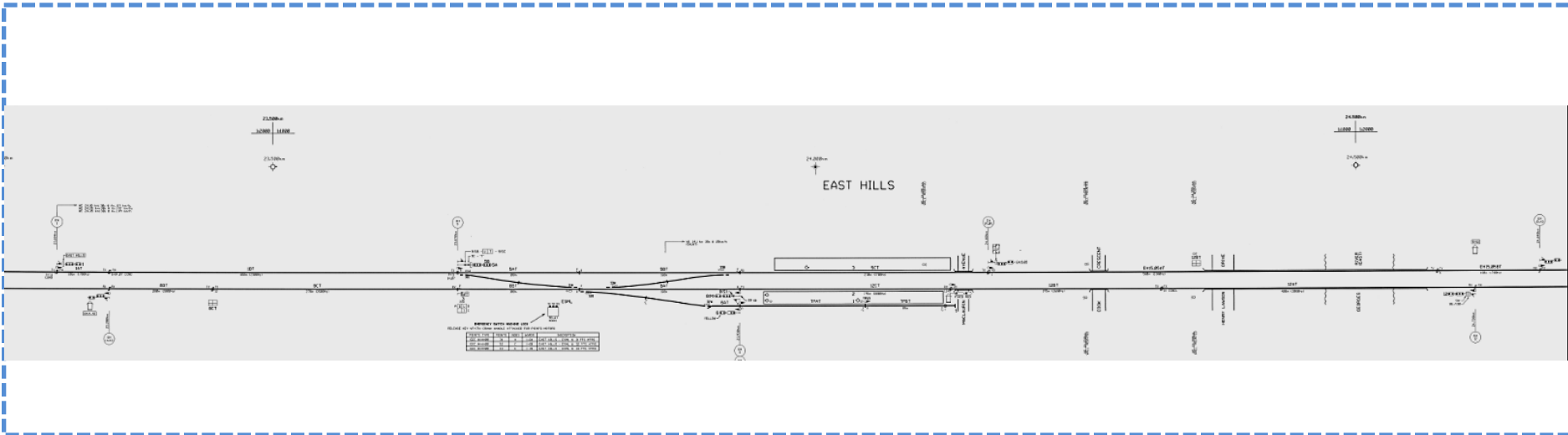

Rail Safety National Law (NSW)

- Safety of railway operations
- Safe systems for carrying out the railway operations - developed & implemented
- Rail safety worker
 - is of sufficient good health and fitness
 - competent to undertake that work
 - not impaired by alcohol or drugs
 - not fatigued
- Provision of adequate facilities for the safety of persons at any railway premises
- Provision of training and supervision of rail safety workers
- Provision of maintenance of rail infrastructure that is safe
- Any design, construction, commissioning, use, installation, modification, maintenance, repair or decommissioning of the manager's rail infrastructure is done or carried out in a way that ensures the safety of railway operations
- Systems and procedures for the scheduling, control and monitoring of railway operations are established and maintained so as to ensure the safety of the manager's railway operations
- Communications systems and procedures are established and maintained so as to ensure the safety of the manager's railway operations
