



## Barangaroo Wharf construction will continue in October 2017

In planning for Tomorrow's Sydney we have built a new wharf at Barangaroo, increasing Sydney's ferry capacity and servicing the thousands of residents, visitors and workers travelling to and from the Barangaroo commercial and residential district.

### What we're doing at Barangaroo

#### Out of hours work

- **Tuesday, 3 October – Wednesday, 4 October 2017**

To ensure the safety of workers and commuters, some work activities will need to be undertaken at night. This includes removal of the layover pontoons on both wharves 1 and 2 on **Tuesday, 3 October and Wednesday, 4 October 2017 from 10pm-5am each night**. Equipment to be used includes a silenced generator on a crane barge, hand and power tools. The hand and power tool work will involve short durations of hammering and, possibly, grinding.

- **Monday, 9 October – Friday, 13 October 2017**

Modification works to a ladder secured on a pile in front of Wharf 1 will be undertaken on **one night between Monday, 9 October to Friday, 13 October 2017 during nightshift from 2am to 6am, weather and site conditions permitting**. It will involve use of divers and equipment such as a small barge with crane and hand and power tools.

Every effort will be made to reduce the impact to residents while work takes place. You may experience some noise during the works. Machinery will be switched off when not in use to minimise noise. Whilst lighting on the vessels being used to undertake these works is required to do it safely, strategies will be put in place to limit light spill.

## Rectification works

Minor finishing works continue for the construction of Barangaroo Wharf, including modification works such as finishing trims on glass balustrades and painting. This work will be completed during standard work hours which are:

- 7am to 7pm Monday to Friday
- 7am to 5pm Saturdays.
