Transport Access Program

Harris Park Station Upgrade

Community Notification

January 2018

The Transport Access Program is a Transport for NSW initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering accessible, modern, secure and integrated transport infrastructure.

Project Overview

Harris Park Station Upgrade is progressing rapidly, with many of the new changes now visible to the community. The lift shaft has been erected, and glazing is complete. The eastern access ramp construction is now complete, providing an accessible pathway with upgraded lighting, CCTV and handrails.

The new access on Station Street West is partially open, with an accessible ramp to the concourse. The pedestrian crossing has been temporarily relocated until early 2018, when roadworks will occur to create a 'shared zone' for cars and pedestrians. Works at this time will also include the progression of canopies and roofing on the concourse.

There will be a short break in construction over Christmas and New Years, commencing from Saturday 23 December 2017 and resuming works on Saturday 6 January 2018. Downer Group and Transport for NSW would like to wish all residents a happy and safe holiday and thank you for your patience and cooperation throughout the project.

Upcoming out of hours works

From 2am Saturday 6 January to 2am Monday 8 January 2018

Works this weekend will include the delivery of the lift via a crane onto platform 3/4, replacement of the old canopy and roofing on platform 3/4 including gutters and downpipes. Roofing works will occur on the concourse including cabling, lighting and roof panel installation, as well as the forming and installation of skylight roof panels on the footbridge.

Temporary Change to Access

- **Access to the footbridge from Station Street West will be CLOSED to pedestrians.** An alternate pedestrian route, via Cambridge Street, is indicated on the map on the following page.
- **Station Street West will be closed to traffic from Cambridge Street to Marion Street, with residents only access.** Traffic control will be in place to allow safe access for residents, and to direct traffic around the detour. Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.
- **Commuters can access trains running from platforms 1 and 2 from the east ramp via Cambridge Street.** The pedestrian route is indicated on the map below.

This work may be noisy at times. Every effort will be made to minimise the noise impact on nearby residents and businesses.

Please see map below for Harris Park Station access, pedestrian routes and traffic detours. For enquiries regarding rail services normal operating from platform 3/4 during the weekend works, please contact the **Transport Infoline on 131 500.**



From 2am Saturday 27 January to 2am Monday 29 January 2018

Works this weekend will include the installation of structural steel and roofing works over the eastern entry to the station. This will also include the installation of balustrades and new anti-throw screens.

Traffic control will be present to direct traffic and pedestrians to safe access pathways. This work may be noisy at times. Every effort will be made to minimise the noise impact on nearby residents and businesses.

Temporary Change to Access

- **Access to the footbridge from the eastern ramp will be CLOSED to pedestrians.** An alternate pedestrian route, via Wigram street, is indicated on the map on the following page.
- **Commuters can access trains running from platforms 3 and 4 from Station Street West.** The pedestrian route is indicated on the map below.
