In Sydney I am led to believe 75% of taxi fares are Rank & Hail which means city taxi plates will retain some market value & will pay the \$1 levy on ONLY 25% of total fares.

Country taxis experience only 15% Rank & Hail work leaving the plate price decimated & the \$1 levy (85%) obligation astronomical.

In all fairness I feel the \$1 levy should apply to the same percentage of total fares (25%?) across all point to point providers.

This "levelling of the playing field" will effect the collection in time only.
