Rooty Hill Station Upgrade and Commuter Car Park



The NSW Government is improving accessibility and commuter parking at Rooty Hill Station.

Have your say on the proposed improvements to Rooty Hill Station and Commuter Car Park. Key features include:

- four new lifts to provide access at station entrances and platforms
- new pedestrian footbridge and stairs
- new multi-storey car park providing more than 300 new parking spaces
- new lift to provide access within the new commuter car park
- pedestrian link between the new commuter car park and Rooty Hill Station
- new bicycle racks, a family accessible toilet and larger platform canopies
- new pedestrian links and crossings to the station and bus stops
- upgrades to CCTV and lighting to improve safety and security.

Subject to planning approval, construction is expected to commence in early 2018 and to be complete in 2020.



Project objectives

The objectives of the Rooty Hill Station Upgrade and Commuter Car Park project seeks to provide:

- a station precinct that is accessible to those with a disability, the ageing, parents/carers with prams and customers with luggage
- modern buildings and facilities for all modes of transport that meet the needs of a growing population
- modern interchanges that support an integrated network and allow seamless transfers between all modes for all customers
- improved customer experience and amenity (weather protection, better interchange facilities and visual appearance)
- upgrades which respond to the heritage values of the site.
