

Sydney Growth Trains Mortdale Maintenance Centre

DECEMBER 2017 WORK NOTIFICATION

Sydney Growth Trains is the centrepiece of the More Trains, More Services program and will provide customers with more frequent and more express services. The NSW Government has ordered 24 new eight-car suburban trains, meaning more reliable and comfortable commuter services will begin rolling onto the tracks from late 2018.

The new SGT fleet will be maintained and serviced at the Auburn Maintenance Centre. The move to the Auburn facility will support the new train timetable that will provide the largest ever capacity increase to the Sydney train network at one time, giving customers more of what they need.

Mortdale Maintenance Centre

Mortdale Maintenance Centre will continue to be upgraded to enable the maintenance of our expanding train fleets and prepare our network for the future needs of a growing Sydney. Completion of the upgrade works at Mortdale will support the NSW Government's Medium Term Rail Plan. Downer is delivering the work on behalf of Transport for NSW.

Key features of the upgrade include track and overhead wiring work, installation of maintenance equipment inside the existing facility along with lighting and electrical upgrades. The upgrade is expected to be completed in February 2018.

Upcoming work

During December 2017, work will include structural modifications, electrical and track works and other minor works within the maintenance facilities. Equipment that may be used includes power and hand tools, cranes and elevated work platforms and trucks including concrete trucks

Standard construction hours are **7am** to **6pm** Monday to Friday and **8am** to **1pm** on Saturday. The work may be noisy at times but all efforts will be made to minimise the noise.

During December work will also take place between 9am and 8.30pm on:

- Saturday 9 December and Sunday 10 September
- Saturday 16 December and Sunday 17 December

And, between 8am and 6pm on:

- Saturday 23 December and Sunday 24 December
- Saturday 30 December and Sunday 31 December
