Project Update

Work at Victoria Street Station is progressing well, with essential services recently installed below the station platform. New palisade fencing was installed along Waller Street and Victoria Street within the last month, as well as the new family accessible toilet being opened for customer use.

This month, work will continue within the station building and the installation of the lift shaft on Waller Street.

Upcoming weekend work

Nightly from 8pm to 8am - Tuesday 10 October and Wednesday 11 October 2017

Work will take place to remove spoil off the platform. Equipment approved for use during this period includes an excavator, dump truck and a lighting tower.

The works planned to occur during the Sydney Trains shutdown period provide safe access for workers and minimise disruption to rail users. These works may be noisy at times.

Work activities have been scheduled to minimise the noise impact on nearby residents.

From 3am Saturday 28 October to 1am Monday 30 October 2017

Work over the weekend includes drainage works, resurfacing of the platform and works within the station building. These works have been planned during a scheduled Sydney Trains shutdown weekend to provide safe access for workers and minimise disruption to rail users.

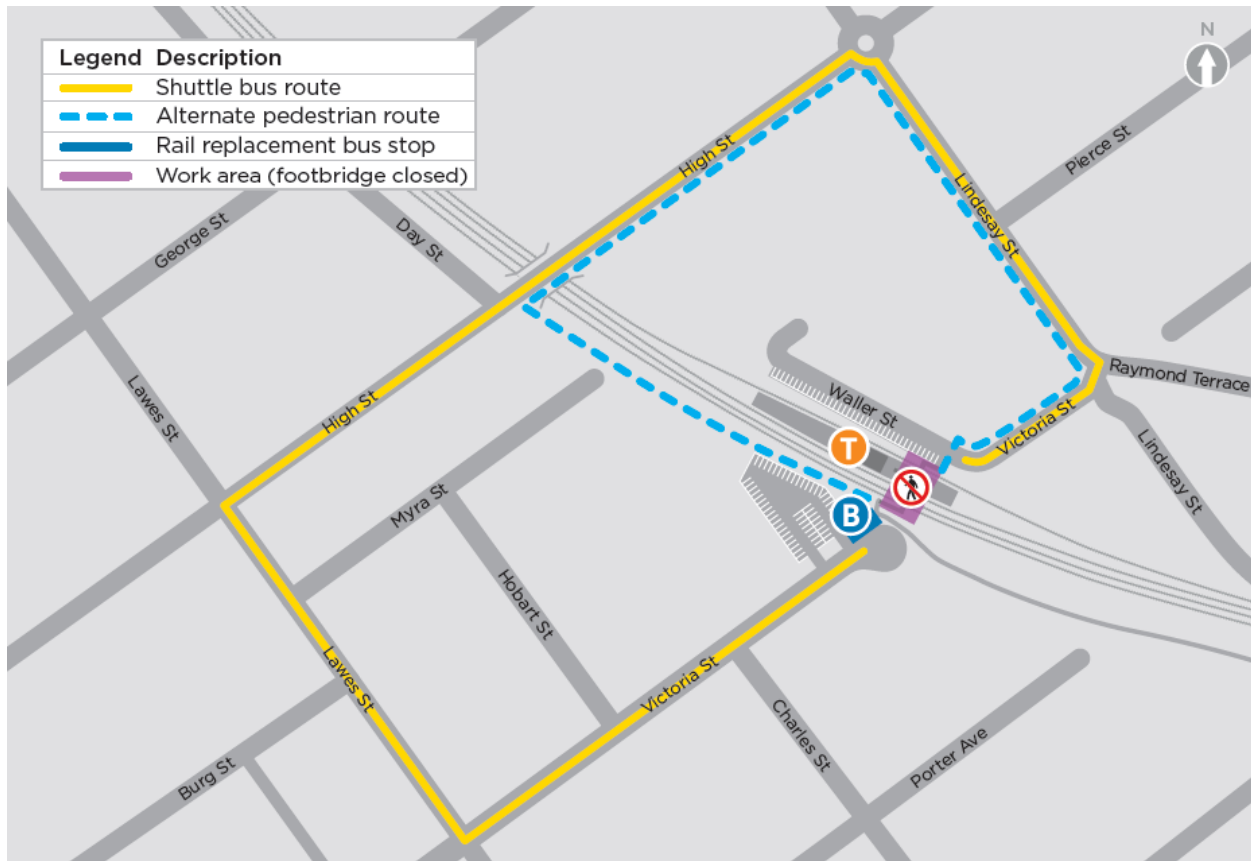
- **No parking will be available in the Waller Street carpark from 6pm Friday 27 October to 2am Monday 30 October 2017.**

During this period, buses will replace trains from Victoria Street. For enquiries regarding rail services during the weekend works, please contact the Transport Infoline on 131 500

Victoria Street Station footbridge will be CLOSED during this period. A complementary shuttle bus service will operate between Victoria Street and Waller Street.

The shuttle bus will remain on Victoria Street, commuters leaving from Waller Street are to request the traffic control onsite to call the shuttle bus, to be picked up and transported to Victoria Street.

Alternatively, pedestrians can use the walking track marked on the map on the page overleaf.



From 12.30am to 3am on Monday 6 November 2017

During this short window where no trains are running, we will be craning in lifts shafts to the platform and Waller Street. The crane will be set up and operating from Waller Street.

Traffic control will be present to direct traffic and pedestrians to safe access pathways.

Victoria Street Station footbridge will remain open to pedestrians and trains will run as normal.

Every effort will be made to minimise the noise impact on nearby residents and businesses.

Standard construction hours

Construction on the Victoria Street Station Upgrade will be undertaken throughout the month during standard working hours, which are

- 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday, and
- 8am to 1pm Saturday

Notification of any other works occurring outside these standard hours will be given prior to works commencing.
