WYNYARD WALK





Wynyard Walk construction will continue in September and October 2017

In planning for Tomorrow's Sydney we have built a fully accessible pedestrian link between Wynyard Station and the developing CBD western corridor and Barangaroo.

What we're doing in the CBD

The new Clarence Street entrance to Wynyard Station provides direct access between the station, Clarence Street and reconnects to the old Kent Street tunnel.

Minor construction activities continue for the construction of Wynyard Walk. This includes the finishing touches of the Clarence Street entry building and ground floor of Railway House.

During September and October 2017, construction work will take place during the day and periodically at night at the Clarence Street work site and York Lane.

Equipment to be used includes hand and power tools, scissor lifts and elevated work platforms.

Day work

Dayshift works will occur for **approximately two weeks from Thursday, 21 September 2017** during the following periods:

- 6am to 7pm Monday to Friday
- 8am to 6pm Saturday and Sunday

Construction activities will include:

- delivery and removal of equipment and material for the internal fit out and finishes
- building and installing security bollards in York Lane
- minor rectification work.

Night work

Nightshift works will occur for approximately two weeks from Thursday, 28 September 2017 during the following periods:

6pm to 7am Sunday to Friday as required

Construction activities will include:

- inspection works to the external façade
- installation of security bollards in York Lane
- minor rectification work.

How will this work affect you?

Noise and other impacts

You may experience some noise during this work. Every effort will be made to reduce the impact to residents and businesses while work takes place.

Traffic and pedestrian changes

During all works in York Lane, there will be road closures. Traffic management personnel will be in place to help direct vehicles and facilitate access to driveways. Pedestrian access through York Lane will be maintained at all times. Signage will be installed to direct pedestrians.

There will also be parking lane closures on Clarence Street during weeknight works to facilitate inspection and maintenance work on the external façade. Signage will be installed to notify users and traffic management personnel will be on duty.
